### Dear Hydrographer,

- 1. In the Circular Letters in reference, the IHO Secretariat announced the selected candidates who would benefit from the opportunity offered by the joint IHO-Nippon Foundation GEOMAC (Geospatial Marine Analysis and Cartography) Project fully funded by the Nippon Foundation.
- 2. In February 2021, after reviewing the situation of the COVID-19 pandemic, in close liaison with the UKHO as conducting partner, the IHO Secretariat decided on the second postponement of the 12<sup>th</sup> GEOMAC course to September 2021, previously planned to commence in January/February 2021. Unfortunately, the actual situation has not improved and many countries still have international travel restrictions.
- 3. The IHO Secretariat, after a careful review and discussions with Nippon Foundation, UKHO and JHOD and having in consideration that the highest priority is always the safety of the people involved in the course, hereby announce the third postponement of the 12<sup>th</sup> GEOMAC course now to February 2022 and advise the Member States and the selected candidates to follow further instructions from the UKHO.
- 4. The IHO Secretariat would also like to announce that the entire schedule of the threeyear GEOMAC Project courses has been updated and adjusted to the current circumstances, as described in the Annex to this Circular Letter.


