MASTER OF SCIENCE PROGRAMME IN HYDROGRAPHIC SCIENCE AT THE UNIVERSITY OF SOUTHERN MISSISSIPPI (USA) SPONSORED BY THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA

SELECTION OF CANDIDATES (11th Course, 6 August 2023 - 2 August 2024)

Reference: IHO CL 34/2022, dated 05 September 2022 - Master of Science Programme in Hydrographic Science at the University of Southern Mississippi (USA) sponsored by the Republic of Korea - Call for Nominations (11th Course)

Dear Hydrographer,

- 1. In the reference, the IHO Secretariat invited the IHO Member States to consider nominating one suitable candidate who would benefit from the opportunity offered by the IHO-Republic of Korea (ROK) Programme of Technical Cooperation to enrol in the 2023-2024 session of the Category "A" Master of Science in Hydrographic Science at the University of Southern Mississippi (USM), USA. The budget allocation from the ROK fund to sponsor the training for this session will be available for two students.
- 2. The IHO Secretariat received applications from thirteen countries. The Selection Panel, comprising representatives from the ROK, the IHO Secretariat, the USM and the Chair of Capacity Building Sub-Committee as an observer, met in person on 07 February 2023 and examined all the applications.
- 3. The candidates from Romania (Mr Cristian-Ionel VASILIU) and from Türkiye (Mr Mustafa KANAT) were assessed as meeting all necessary criteria and were selected for the session that will be held at the USM from 6 August 2023 (reporting date) to 2 August 2024 (departure date). Individual notification letters have been sent to the selected applicants with detailed instructions. The candidates from Mauritius (Mr Hunish Kumar Mattarooa) and from Nigeria (Mr Onogateoghene Eduvie Idoge) are the first and the second reserve candidates respectively.
- 4. In accordance with Annex C of the Reference (Timetable for the selection of candidates), the selected candidates must submit all the required documentation to the USM in liaison with Professor Stephan HOWDEN (e-mail: Stephan.Howden@usm.edu), Director of Hydrographic Science Research Center at the USM. The selected candidates will receive detailed logistic information directly from the USM.

In particular, prospective candidates should ensure that they have all the necessary documentation readily available well in advance, especially the necessary TOEFL or IELTS scores.
- 6. The IHO Secretariat congratulates the candidates who have been selected and thanks the IHO Member States for their interest.
- 7. The IHO Secretariat would also like to renew its sincere thanks to the Republic of Korea for its substantial support to the IHO Capacity Building and other programmes.
