Executive Summary:	This document provides a summary report of the CB activities at EAHC.

Introduction / Background

1. The EAHC comprises of 10 Member States; Brunei Darussalam, China, Democratic People's Republic of Korea, Indonesia, Japan (Vice Chair), Malaysia (Chair), Philippines, Republic of Korea, Singapore and Thailand. In addition, Vietnam became an IHO Member State in March 2015, and is waiting for the approval of EAHC Membership.
2. At the 6th TRDC Board of Director (BOD) meeting in February 2017 in Japan, the EAHC CB activities were reviewed and planned for 2018. A SWOT analysis for long term plan was carried out to identify the EAHC's Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities and Threats it faced.
