Introduction - background

1. A five-year plan for CB activity in the SAIHC region was approved by the membership in 2012. This plan covers the period 2013-2017 and is reviewed annually (during SAIHC meetings) to ensure it meets regional requirements. The plan is based on assessing the phase of development of each of the coastal states within the SAIHC region (as determined by the IHO's three phases of CB) and arranging training activity to build the necessary capability to meet SOLAS treaty obligations. There is a great deal of 'SOLAS awareness' required in this region. At the last SAIHC meeting in Cape Town, South Africa, August 2016 the SAIHC CB Coordinator presented a further three year SAIHC CB Plan to cover the period 2018-2020. The members endorsed this plan.

2. A Phase 1 Skills training course was delivered in Walvis Bay, Namibia in July 2016 for the following coastal states:- Comoros, Kenya, Madagascar, Malawi, Mauritius, Mozambique, Namibia (2) and Seychelles
