Executive Summary: This document provides a summary report of the EAHC 3-year Work Plan to the CBSC.

- 2. The EAHC has tasked the TRDC BOD to plan, implement and monitor CB programmes, and approved the five-year Capacity Building work plan proposed by the TRDC BOD which has a systematic approach for basic and specialized programmes. However due to the limited CB fund, only a small number of programmes were funded by the CBSC/IHO. Therefore a number of the proposed programmes have not been implemented.
- 3. For the IHO Capacity Building strategy classifies phases of the development of hydrographic and cartographic capability as 3 phases, the EAHC capacity building phase stages are as follows;

- 5. Training for Trainers (TFT) courses are highly valued by the Commission since they nurture trainers to return to their home countries and train others in their mother tongues. This will lead to more effective outcome as most Member States are non-English speaking countries. For this reason, they have higher priority in the CB Work Plan of the EAHC.
- 6. The EAHC has been conducting the TFT course since 2013. The 1st TFT Carto Workshop took place in November 2013 and the 2nd was in November 2014 both in the ROK. In 2014 master trainers delivered a basic course in their own countries. As for the TFT Hydro, the ROK will host the 1st TFT Basic Hydro in October 2016 for EAHC MSs and the Phase 2 of the course will be held in 2017.
