1. Introduction / Background

A three-year plan for CB activity in the EAHC¹ region was approved by the membership at the 8th EAHC Training, Research and Development Centre (TRDC) Board of Directors (BOD) meeting in March 2018. This plan covers the period 2018-2020 and is reviewed annually during TRDC-BOD meetings to ensure it meets regional requirements. It is based on assessing the phase of development of each of the coastal states within the EAHC region (as determined by the IHO's three phases of CB).

Many training activities were delivered in 2017 in the region but there is still a significant level of technology gap among the ten MSs. In particular it was agreed that developing countries need continuous CB activities to enhance their basic capacity in hydrographic surveying and charting. Moreover, taking into account the region is one of the areas with largest marine traffic in the world, capacity building in managing maritime safety information (MSI) and risk assessment was raised and reflected in the submissions for 2019 CB activities accordingly.
