(i) LES Pune (India) – at 1000 and 2200 UTC. Urgent warnings are broadcasted as occasion demands.

(ii) Coastal Warnings for Reunion are broadcasted by LES Aussaguel at 0040 and 1240 UTC.

(iii) Coastal Warnings for Mayotte are broadcasted by LES Aussaguel at 0330 and 1530 UTC.

(d) Scheduled Broadcast of Meteorological Warnings.

(i) LES Pune (India) - 0900 and 1800 UTC (for North of equator).

(ii) LES Aussaguel - 0130 and 1330 UTC (for Mauritius/Reunion and South of Equator). Tropical Cyclone warnings prepared and issued by Reunion – 0000, 0600, 1200 and 1800 UTC.

(iii) Australia - Tropical cyclone warnings, if any are prepared and issued by Australia as unscheduled broadcasts for area South of Equator and East of 90° via Burum.

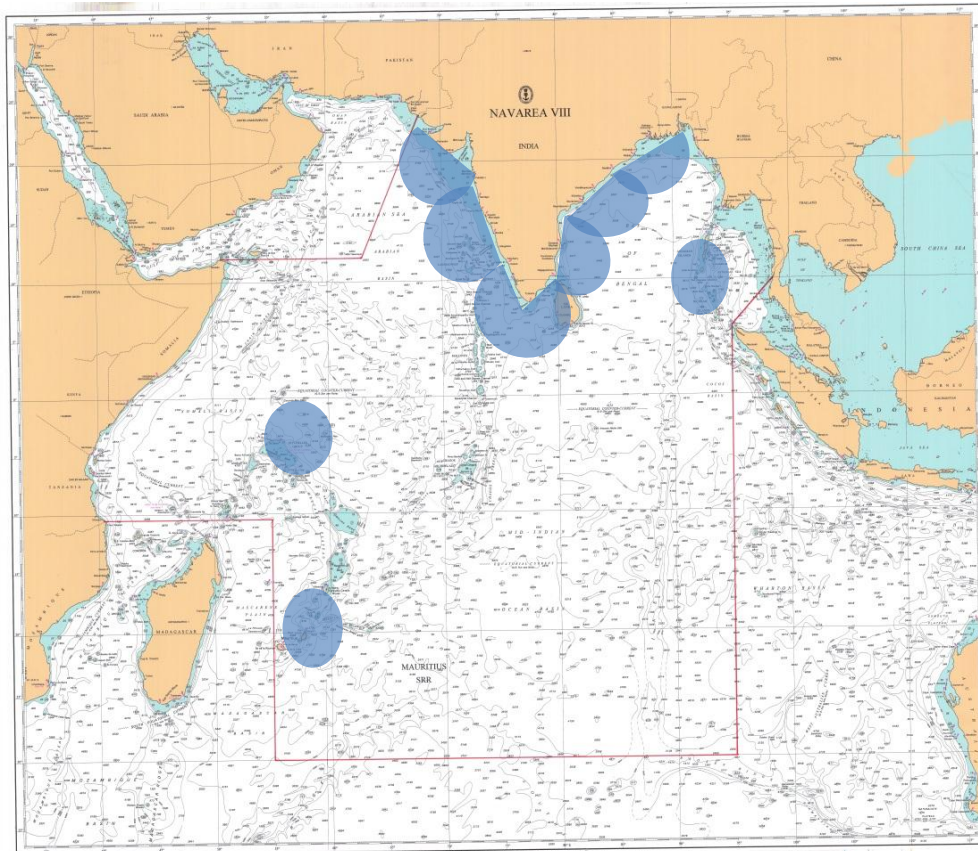
