


Fig. 1. Bathymetric map of the Soseki Ridges. Contours are in 100 m.




Fig. 2. Bathymetric map of the Soseki Ridges, shown with track lines. Contours are in 100 m.




Fig. 3. Bathymetric profile across the Soseki Ridges.
