Highlights of regional collaboration and follow up achievements

- Further development of an active Marine Spatial Data Infrastructure Working Group, led by UK
- SAIHC has established a Crowd Source Bathymetry (CSB) and Seabed2030 Coordinator
- Virtual two-day MSDI Awareness Training Course delivered, January 21
- Hydrographic Awareness Seminar delivered in May 22 improving regional engagement



 The African Great Lakes & Rivers Sub Working Group has been formed, with a meeting and practical demonstration 5-6th December 2022 in Lilongwe, Malawi





Activities contributing to the strategic goals and targets of the IHO

- Additional two Member States joined IHO within SAIHC region, Angola and Kenya
- Hydrographic Awareness Seminar led to a focused inter-sessional meeting to consider the Strategic Performance Indicators (SPIs) and Gap analysis across Member States
- The ICCWG continues to coordinate the INT charting coverage and reduce ENC overlaps and gaps.



- IHO Capacity Building Fund supporting training and Technical Assessment Visits in Comoros, Tanzania and Mozambique
- S100 implementation to be discussed at SAIHC19, August 2023
