

Highlights of regional collaboration and follow up achievements

- Good participation in IHO e-Learning Center and CB training.
- A better ENC coverage in the region achieved, which in turn means better coverage of unsurveyed areas in RSAHC region.
- The RSAHC encourage nomination of a coordinator to promote establishment of MSDI working group and S-100 Services Coordinator for RSAHC.
- There has been a high level of industry participation in RSAHC meetings with many opportunities to share experiences and contribute to discussions.





Activities contributing to the strategic goals and targets of the IHO

- Member States in Region started training for S-100 implementation, S100 implementation was discussed at 9 th RSAHC.
- The next Chair of RSAHC (for 2023-2025) have been determined, Saudi Arabia will be the next Chair.
- Good progress is being made with the aspirations of nations to attain IHO Membership, Iraq to sign the RSAHC statutes.
- A technical visit of Iran and Iraq to be arranged by IHO and IALA.
