This letter provides information on the 23rd meeting of the GEBCO Sub-Committee on Undersea Feature Names (SCUFN23) to be held in Callao near Lima, Peru, on 11-14 September 2010, and proposes a provisional agenda for the meeting. - 1. The Peruvian Hydrographic Office (DHN) has kindly offered to host all 2010 GEBCO meetings in Callao near Lima, therefore including the 23rd SCUFN meeting. "Members are expected to attend every meeting of the Sub-Committee. Sub-Committee Members who are absent from meetings over two consecutive years will normally be considered to have resigned and new nominations shall be sought from the relevant parent organization."

SCUFN members are therefore urged to take appropriate measures to attend SCUFN23.
