Dear Mr Alekseev,

This letter intends to inform you of our decision on the appointment of a new IOC appointed member of the GEBCO Sub-Committee on Undersea Feature Names (SCUFN).

Following the the 31st SCUFN meeting (SCUFN-31) (Wellington, New Zealand, 23-27 October 2018), one of the IOC seat was deemed to be vacant in accordance with Rule of Procedure 2.5. I therfore invited IOC Member States to nominate candidates to fill this vacancy for the IOC membership of SCUFN, according to commonly agreed criteria.

After reviewing the candidates nominated by IOC Member States in terms of qualifications and experiences relevant to GEBCO, and having notified the Chair of SCUFN and the IHO Secretariat, I am pleased to inform you that I have decided to appoint you to serve as the new member of SCUFN for a period of five years:
