Logistics Information

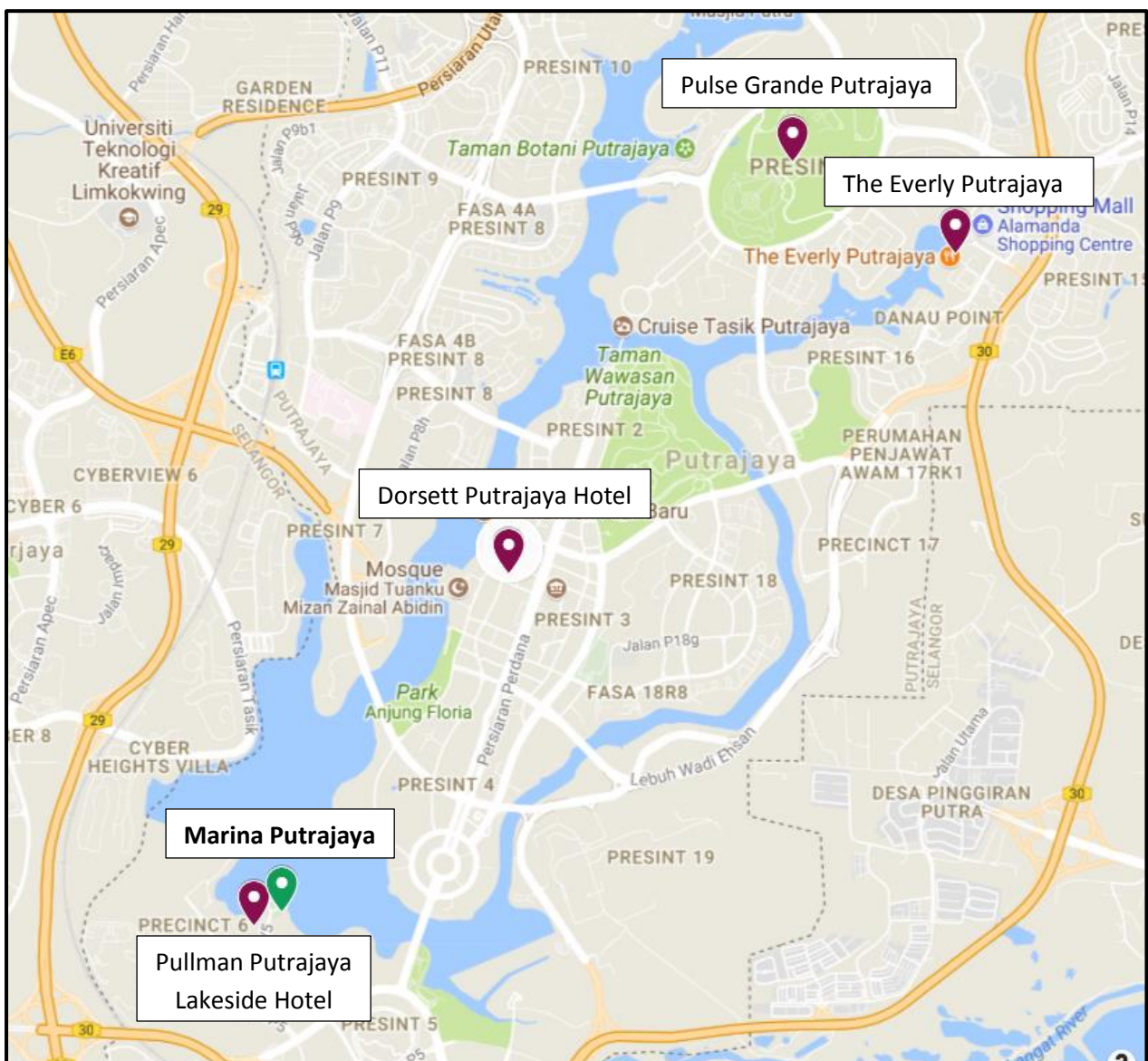
1. Venue

The 13th EAHC Conference Meeting will take place at Laksamana Hall, Marina Putrajaya, Malaysia while the HydroSEA Conference & Exhibition 2018 will be held at Armada Hall, Marina Putrajaya, Malaysia.

2. Accommodation

Participants are expected to make their own accommodation arrangements; however, assistance can be provided as needed. Anyone requiring assistance is invited to contact the secretariat team.

Participants are encouraged to stay at the Pullman Putrajaya Lakeside Hotel because it is within 200m walking distance to the Conference venue.



Below is the list of hotels nearby Marina Putrajaya:

- a. **Pullman Putrajaya Lakeside (200m from Marina Putrajaya)**

- b. **Grand Dorsett (4.6km)**

- c. **Pulse Grande Hotel (9.6km)**
Taman Putra Perdana, Precinct 1, 62502 Putrajaya, Malaysia
- d. **The Everly Putrajaya (11.9km)**
No. 1, Jalan Alamanda 2, Precinct 1, 62000 Putrajaya, Malaysia

3. Getting There

International flights will arrive at KLIA or KLIA 2. Delegates are advised to confirm their flight itinerary to assist the secretariat team for transport arrangements.

Should any of delegates wish to proceed to the hotel on their own, the possible connections from KLIA or KLIA 2 to Putrajaya is by taxi, train (KLIA Transit) and GrabCar.

Taxi from KLIA

The approximate taxi fare from KLIA to Putrajaya is RM 60. There are 3 Taxi Counters at KLIA:

- a. International Arrival Hall (just after Customs, before the public arrival area).
- b. Domestic Arrival Hall (public area after Domestic Baggage Clearance).
- c. Domestic Baggage Reclaim, Arrival Level.

Train from KLIA

Train service (KLIA Transit ERL) is located at Level 1 of the KLIA Main Terminal Building. Train fare to Putrajaya Station is RM 9.40 and the service is available from 5.22 am until 1.03 am (next day). From Putrajaya Station, taxi is available to hotels listed above, with the fee approximately around RM 20.

Taxi from KLIA 2

Taxi services are available at the Transportation Hub located at Level 1 of the Gateway@KLIA2 mall, next to the KLIA 2 Main Terminal Building. Taxi fare from KLIA 2 to Putrajaya is approximately RM 65.

Train from KLIA 2

Train service (KLIA Transit ERL) is located at Level 2 of the Gateway@KLIA2 mall. Train fare to Putrajaya Station is similar from KLIA, RM 9.40. The service is available from 5.22 am until 1.03 am (next day) and taxi is available to hotels listed above, with the fee approximately around RM 20.

GrabCar

GrabCar can easily be booked via Grab app (iOS or Android). A flat rate of RM 65 will be charged for this service. Payment can be made by cash, credit or debit card.

4. Social Dinner

The Chairman's Office will be hosting a dinner for the delegates on 19 September 2018 at Pullman Putrajaya Lakeside Hotel. The attire for the event is smart casual.

5. Visa

All foreigners intending to enter Malaysia must provide the documentation required to justify the reasons and duration of their stay. Visa applications are to be made at the Malaysia Embassy in their place of residence or any other signatory country. Delegates should check before they travel whether or not they will need a visa to enter Malaysia and it is strongly recommended to apply in advance for it.

HydroSEA Conference & Exhibition 2018

Delegates are invited to join the two-day event which starts from 19 to 20 September 2018. The registration fee for HydroSEA Conference & Exhibition 2018 is waived for delegates attending the EAHC Conference. Further information can be obtained through this link, www.hydrographsoutheastasia.com.
