 - The Assembly tasked the Council to conduct a comprehensive review of the Strategic Plan and to provide a draft revised Plan, as appropriate, in time for the consideration of the 2nd ordinary session of the Assembly ...
- Decision C1/37 of the Council
 - The Council decided to establish the Strategic Plan Review Working Group
- IHO Circular Letter 20/2018
 - Adoption of the ToRs and RoPs of the SPRWG and Membership



Terms of reference & membership


- Scoping phase → C-2
 - Review and restate the strategic context
 - Identify deficiencies in the existing plan consider means to address them
 - Establish management plan for drafting revised strategic plan
- Drafting phase → C-3 → A-2
 - Define criteria for measuring success and propose priorities
 - Consider interrelation to budget, WP and performance indicators
 - Prepare draft revised plan in accordance with management plan and timetable
- Membership
 - <u>AU</u>, BR, CA, CL, CN, CO, HR, DK, EC, <u>FR</u>, <u>ID</u>, IR, IT, JP, KR, MO, NL, NO, SG, ES, SU, <u>GB</u>, <u>US</u>, SG/IHO

Outcome of C-2

- C-2 considered evolutions in the strategic context of the IHO
 - Broader requirements for hydrographic data (digital navigation, sustainable blue economy, prevention of marine disasters)
 - New technology (e.g. sensors, UAV, USV, processing techniques ...)
 - Data policies
- C-2 tasked SPRWG to develop a simpler strategic plan, with a small number of overarching strategic goals, including measurable targets to be achieved by 2026
- C-2 adopted a management plan





Drafting group (30th – 31st January 2019)

- Strengthen the support to safe and efficient navigation (current and emerging requirements)
 - Relevant standards and data assurance
 - Improved coverage of MSI provided by coastal States
- Enhance the use of marine environment geospatial data for societal benefits
 - Adoption of S-1XX standards by other organizations
 - New tools and methods to accelerate and increase data coverage (e.g. CSB, SDB ...)
 - Digital platform supporting and promoting regional and international cooperation in MSDI
- Promote IHO as a key partner on the Ocean scene
 - Seabed 2030 and DCDB in support to UN Decade of Ocean Sciences for Sustainable Development
 - UN-GGIM principles
 - Enhance IHO digital communication



Management plan and time line

- 30-31 January 2019 drafting group
- 15 March (resp. 15 April) Draft Goals/Targets/Performance indicators transmitted to HSSC (resp. IRCC) chair for evaluation and comments
- May-June HSSC and IRCC provide feedback to SPRWG
- July-August SPRWG submits proposed IHO SP to Council
- October C-3 reviews proposals on SP
- November Council Report, including proposed SP, submitted to A-2
- April 2020 2nd session of the Assembly (A-2)
