

e-Learning courses in IHO MSs




- Countries which deliver e-Learning courses are Denmark, France, Spain and Republic of Korea.




Dual OS / 3TB Capacity / 10 Mbps





KHOA'S LMS (Learning Management System)



Expected Outcome

- ✓ The IHO e-Learning Center will reinforce CB activities (coordination between online/offline training)
- ✓ International hydrographic technology will be further developed.
- ✓ Technological gap among MSs will be reduced by sharing e-Learning contents.

As-is

- > Absence of an IHO e-Learning governing body
- > Absence of an IHO e-Learning guideline
- Lack of infrastructure such as contents
- > Only four IHO MSs are using e-Learning

To-be

- Establishment of an IHO e-Learning Center
- Development of a standardized IHO
 - e-Learning guideline
- Expansion of IHO e-Learning contents and infrastructure (supported by KHOA)
- > Widely available for use by all IHO MSs


