#### Other CB Activities 2022

- 1. ICA-FIG-IHO Category "A" and "B" training programs.
- 2. SEPRHC will keep developing its own capabilities organizing internships and workshops supported by each State Hydrographic Office budgets. Following the IHO SP:
  - a. MSDI national efforts
  - b. Incorporation of new survey technologies.
  - c. S-1XX trainings.
- 3. Region's States have applicants to invitations received from IHO to UKHO, Korea, UNH and USM training programs.







### **Challenges**

- 1. Technical:
  - a. Migration of the current work structure to the IHO S-100 and S-1XX Universal Hydrographic Data Model.
  - b. Survey of hydrographic and topographic data with AUV's technology.
- 2. Budget: Pandemic drove governments to redirect priorities, declining and reducing resources for Hydrographic Offices.





#### **Achievements and lessons learned**

- 1. Despite pandemic, budget issues and non-financed projects, the Region works hard to stay at the forefront with its capabilities. Either on the production line, surveys and capacity building.
- 2. Development of virtual education, but in hydrography, practical teaching is definitively necessary. Competence learning models, attitude and aptitudes to become complete professionals.
- 3. The last couple of years, adaptation has been the motto.





### **Conclusions, Remarks and Actions Required**

- 1. Many challenges have been faced globally and by the Region, nevertheless and against the odds, SEPRHC is committed to keep designing, proposing and carrying out Capacity Building activities according to IHO SP.
