


IHO MEMBERSHIP

PREPARATIONS OF 8TH MEETING OF IHO COUNCIL

- IHO Annual Report for 2023 and Approval of the Finance Report for 2023 (see CCL 02/2024):
 - ✓ Proposals of the Secretary-General already endorsed by the Finance Committee Officers – to allocate the budget surplus for 2023 of 215k€ (40k€ are proposed to be allocated to the Capacity Building Fund for 2024).
- Deadline for submission of proposals by IHO Member States is 15 July 2024



CAPACITY BUILDING

The 2024 CBWP has 293,265€ for non-earmarked projects and 790,223€ for earmarked projects. The total of funds available for 2024 is 1,083,488€. In 2024 the CBWP will return to the pre-COVID practice of not carrying over incomplete activities from yearto-year. Significant increment of the funds for nonearmarked activities was received from Republic of Korea in 2024 and for 2025 (this latter 50% more than in 2024).



CAPACITY BUILDING - COURSES

In 2024, the following courses are:

- CAT A courses at USM sponsored by ROK (2 selected for 11th course 2023/2024; 2 selected for 12th course 2024/2025 starting in August 2024);
- Cat B course in Hydrography at KHOA-ROK from 17 June to 1 November 2024 (10 participants selected with IHO CL 15/2024);
- GEOMAC Cat B course in 2024 sponsored by Nippon Foundation (7 participants selected with IHO CL 17/2024);
- The 21st Course of the IHO-IOC-Nippon Foundation/GEBCO Training Program leading to a Graduate Certificate in Ocean Mapping at the University of New Hampshire (UNH), USA;

The IHO Secretariat is working with Nippon Foundation and the UKHO on a questionnaire regarding the GEOMAC Project.



IHO OUTREACH - WORLD HYDROGRAPHY DAY

IHO CL 01/2024 announced the theme for WHD 2024:

"Hydrographic Information - Enhancing Safety and Efficiency in Marine Activities"

This theme is proposed to highlight that Goal Number 1 of the IHO Strategic Plan and it targets shall have the highest priority in the implementation of the 2024–2026 Work Programme: priority in application of material and human resources, liaison with public sector and industry partners, promotion of concerted regional approaches including increased collaboration with the RENCs, and support of test beds delivering best practice examples for the production, maintenance and distribution of all prioritized S-100 derivatives.



IHO OUTREACH - INTERNATIONAL HYDROGRAPHIC REVIEW

- Dr Patrick Westfield from Germany was confirmed for additional 2 years as IHR Editor.
- The Review is focused in facilitating interdisciplinary knowledge exchange in applied science, as hydrography encompasses fields such as geophysics, oceanography, geodesy, acoustics, cartography, remote sensing and others.
- The recent IHR Vol.30 Ed. May 2024 covers themes as oceanography, geodesy, geology and of course hydrography, with contributions on crowdsourcing water depth data.
