GEOMAC Project (formerly JCBP and CHART Project) is:

- 3-year capacity building programme for cartographers,
- launched in 2008,
- recognized by the IBSC with Category "B"
- financially supported by the Nippon Foundation
- Training course is provided by the UKHO (in Taunton, UK)

Overview (cont'd)

- The current project started in 2023:
 - 1st course was provided in 2023,
 - 2nd course will be in 2024 and
 - 3rd course will be in 2025.
- The students learn:
 - Cartographic basics
 - Compilation and production of ENC and Paper Chart
 - Decision making and processing of new information
 - MSDI, International cooperation projects, Digital Twin and S-100



GEOMAC Project in 2023

- The 15th training course was held from 24 July to 15 December 2023.
- 7 students completed this course.
- 18 applications from 17 countries.



GEOMAC Project in 2024

- The 16th training course will be held from 15 July to 13 December 2024.
- 7 students will be selected.
- The IHO CL03/2024 was issued to call for applications for this course.
- MS can nominate one candidate no later than 4 March 2024.
