Money Exchange and Cash Options

There are numerous outlets available for money exchange.

There is an ATM machine at the hotel.

Please note all credit card transactions have a 4% surcharge in Fiji.

Taxis don't have credit card payment options, so having cash is recommended.

Visa requirements

Depending on your nationality, and the purpose and duration of your visit, you may require a visa to enter Fiji. We urge you to check visa requirements with your travel agent or at the Immigration Fiji website (www.immigration.gov.fi) at your earliest convenience. If you require a letter of invitation, please contact us.





Dress code

The dress code for the meeting and workshop is Smart Casual. Official photographs will be taken on Day 2, Tuesday 5th November.

Transportation to and from the airport

The Nadi International Airport is less than 3 km from the venue. Nadi International Airport is well serviced with taxis if you require transport to your accommodation.

For those booking their room at Tanoa, airport transfer is included, make sure you contact the hotel with your flight details so this service can be arranged.

Electric sockets

In Fiji the power plugs and sockets are of type I. The standard voltage is 240 V.

Type I is mainly used in Australia, New Zealand, China, the South Pacific and Argentina.

On the mainland of Viti Levu, the multi-cultural town of Nadi is the international gateway to Fiji. A bustling tourism hub, Nadi has many options for the visitor.

Fiji enjoys two seasons, summer and winter. The cyclone season falls within the months of November – April. It is during these times when we expect high levels of rainfall. Temperatures are likely to be between 22 and 31°C, which can feel warmer with increased humidity.
