#### Weather

Berlin lies where the influence of the Atlantic Ocean fades and the climate of the continental plain begins. The city's mean annual temperature is about 48 °F (9 °C), and mean temperatures range from 30 °F (-1 °C) in winter to 65 °F (18 °C) in summer. The average precipitation is 22 inches (568 mm). About one-fifth to one-fourth of the total falls as snow.

## 9) Passports and visas:

All meeting participants should check well in advance whether you need a visa to enter Germany and apply within the necessary timeframe. If you need a letter of invitation to support your visa application, please send to the PoC above at your earliest convenience.

## 10) Plugs and voltage:

All power sockets in Berlin provide a standard voltage of 230V with a standard frequency of 50Hz. You can use all your equipment in Berlin if the outlet voltage in your own country is between 220V-240V. This is the case in most of Europe, Australia, the United Kingdom and most countries in Africa and Asia.
