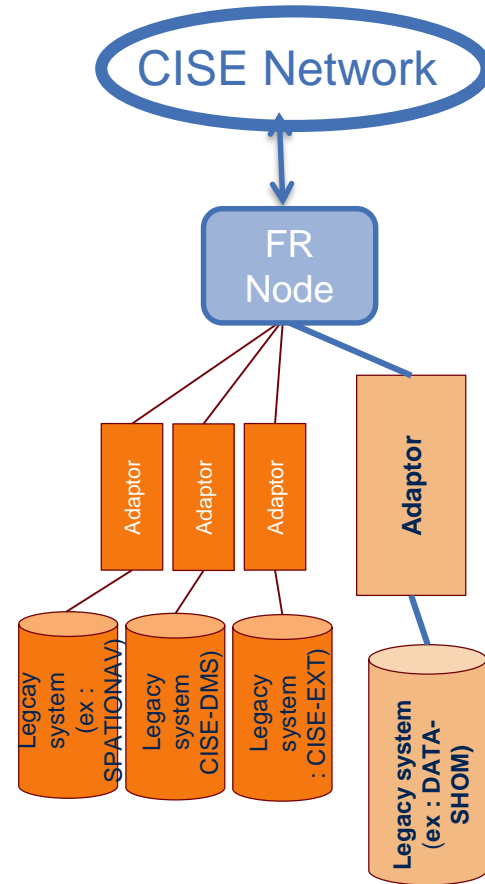
- ***Shom's objectives***

General objectives

To increase the current sharing and alert potential of maritime and border surveillance systems, via CISE and EUROSUR, and by integrating new data sources and new technologies (Datalake, AI).

1.5 years – 5 M€

Next opportunity : EMFAF-2021-PIA-CISE call
