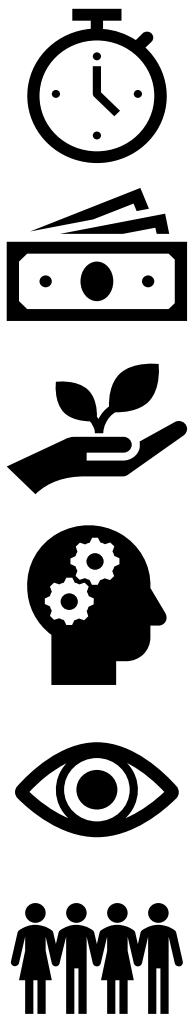

## MISSION:

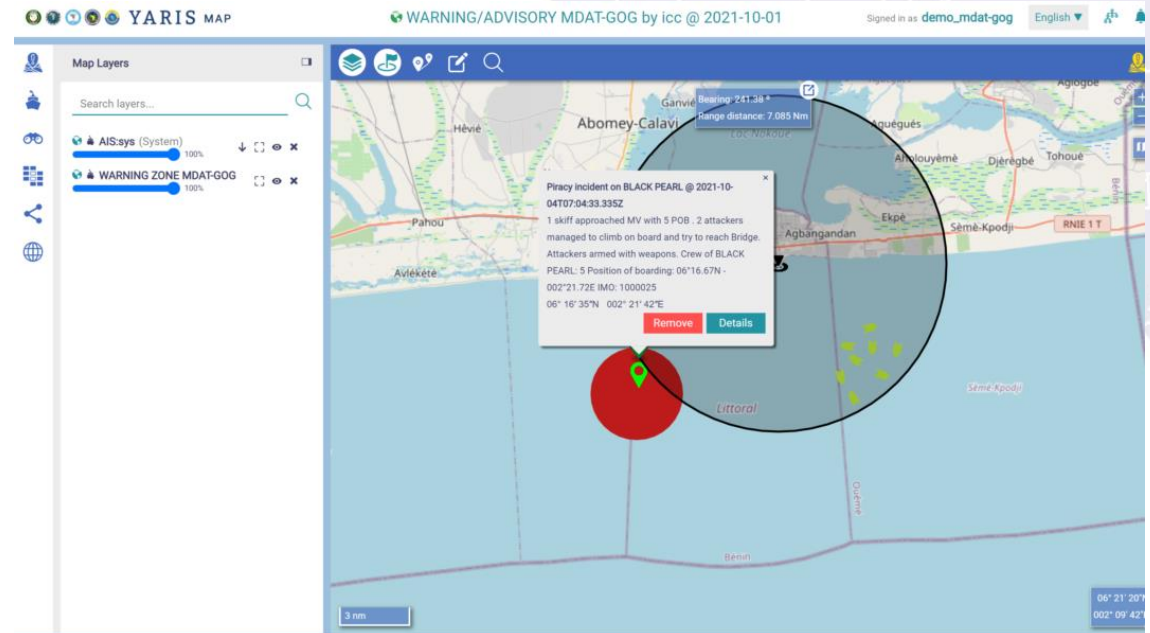
Follow & implement the EU Maritime Strategy for the Gulf of Guinea, in line with the objectives of the “Yaoundé Architecture” by:

## **GoGIN II** – Gulf of Guinea Interregional Network

to strengthen ownership of the **YARIS** maritime information-sharing and coordination platform by regional actors



**Duration:** May 2023 - April 2025 (2 years)

## **SAFE SEAS FOR AFRICA** – Enhancing Maritime Security in Africa

to strengthen the capabilities of **national law enforcement agencies** to investigate criminal acts at sea and support the establishment of the legal finish

to support the fight against **maritime illicit trafficking** between Latin America, the Caribbean and Africa

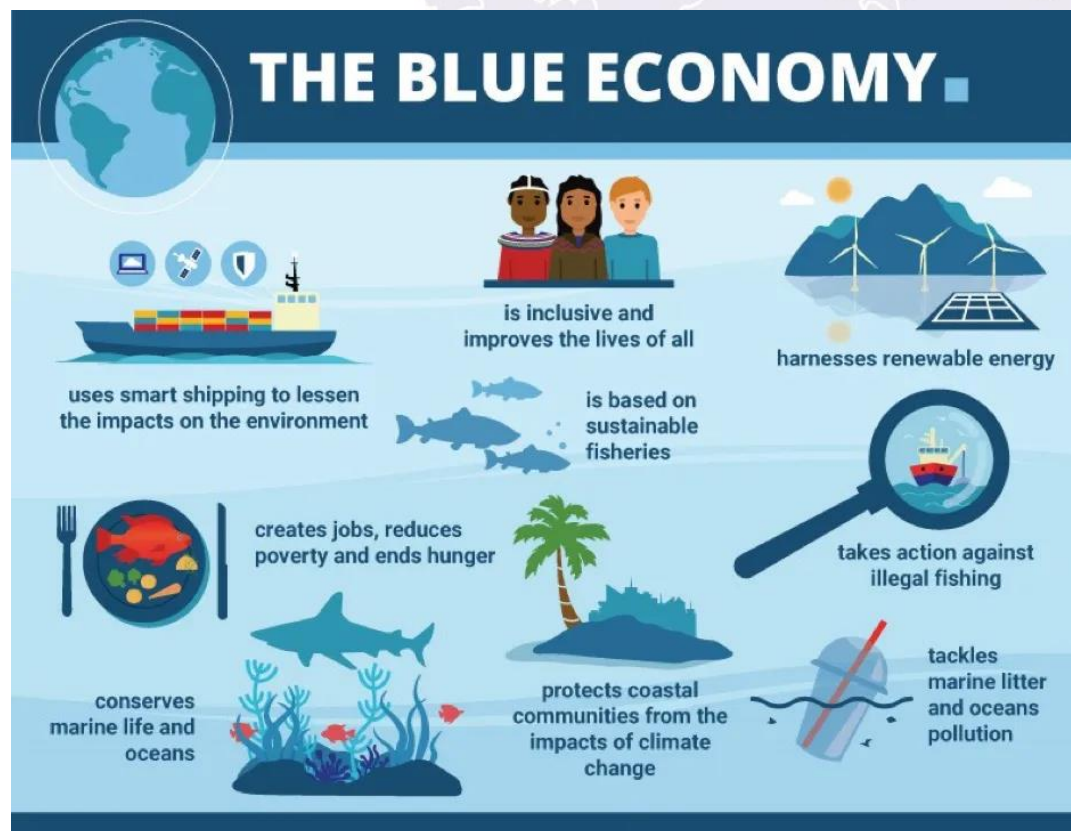


**Duration: November 2023 – October 2026 (3 years)**
