Work on Strategic Plan and Gap Analysis (top 3 aspects)

Need of guidance on the determination of SPI values in regions


 Need to establish a method for measuring percentages of areas adequately surveyed by member states harmonized with other RCHs. (SPI 1.2.2)

• To achieve greater involvement of the member states in objective 3.2 to improve knowledge of the seafloor by promoting the sharing of data with the IHO Data Centre for Digital Bathymetry (DCDB).

Important Findings (RHC top 3 challenges)

- MBSHC is a RCH of small geographic size but with the largest number of countries. Improving Cartographic Coordination in the region is an ongoing task.
- Required effort and cooperation among Member States to face the challenge of implementation of the S-1xx framework of services.
- Successful response of countries in the region to the explosion in the port of Beirut in August 2020 highlights the importance of a good disaster action plan in the HCRs, as well as conduct capacity building webinars/workshops on disaster response.
