Key Achievements

- ARHC have approved Edition 3.0 of the ARHC Statutes, effective 2021-11-20
- ARHC completed Gap Analysis of the IHO Strategic Plan
- Advancing on Pan-Arctic ENC schema different approach needed north of 67° North
- ARHC MS continue to test and operationalize new technologies (i.e. USV, SDB) as well as CSB.

Important Findings (ARHCtop 3 challenges)

- Continued implementation in IHO Strategic Plan Challenges summarized in Append B of report.
- Continue progress on pan-Arctic chart schema foundational for S1XX implementation
- More progress needed on a federated Arctic MSDI gaps in coverage and usable web services continue to exist.

Lessons Learned

- Lack of F2F engagement have delayed activities of ARHC.
- ARHC and related WG have challenges to secure human and technical resources.
- Geographic scale and environment conditions in the Arctic are daunting.
