## IHO Important Findings (RHC top 3 challenges)

- S-100 : Generate Regional strategy for the implementation of the new S-100 standard and it's derivatives, focused on financing, training and incorporation of new technologies.
- GEBCO: A coordinator is appointed, and it is agreed that member states will provide bathymetric data to the GEBCO-Seabed 2030 project.
- CBSC: Implement the 3-year capacity building plan for the region SEPRHC.
  - a) Migration to the OHI S-100 standard and it's derived standards.
  - b) Data infraestructures, management, processing and quality control.
  - c) Use of new technologies in hydrographic surveys.
