6 th (Mar. 2022)	Guideline, demonstration of system and website



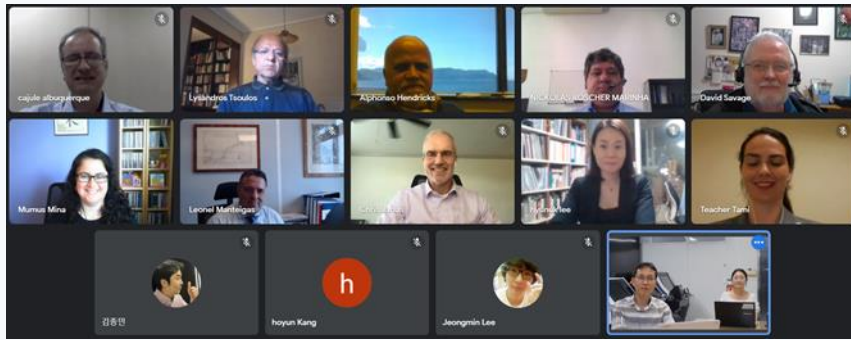

- Drafting of the IHO e-Learning Center Guidelines.

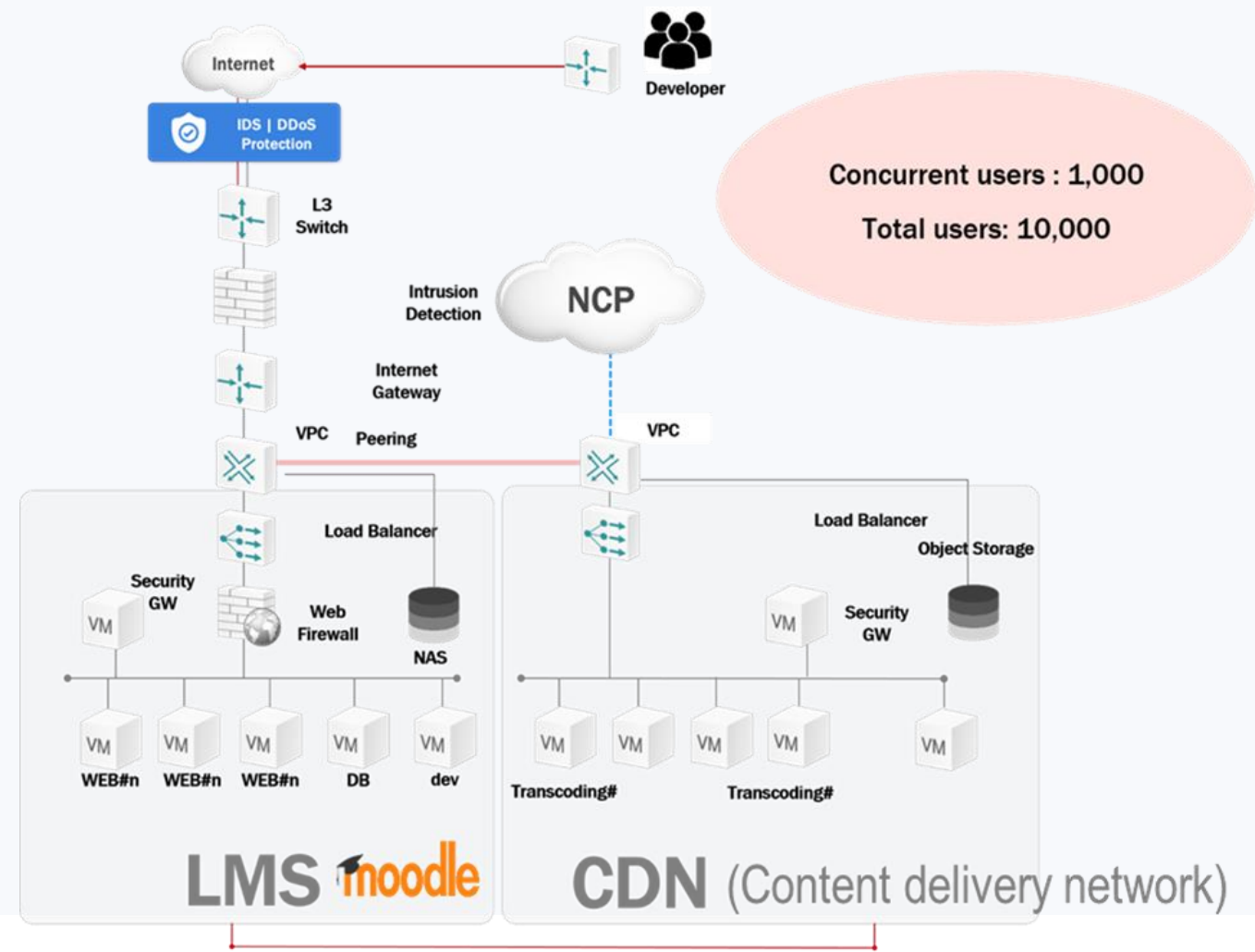


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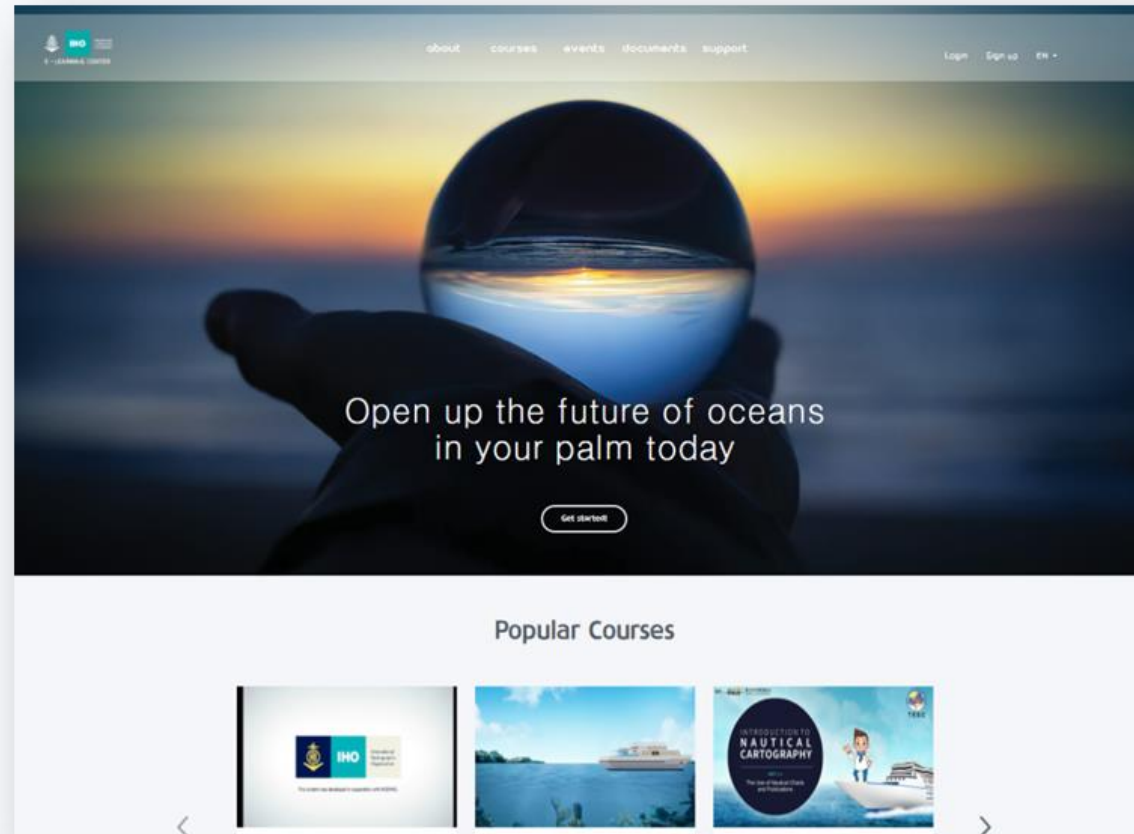
