1. MEETINGS VENUE

Genoa is the capital of the Italian region Liguria and it is the sixth largest city in Italy. In 2021, 566.000 people lived within the city's administrative limits. Over 1.5 million people live in the wider metropolitan area along the Riviera Ligure. Located in the Gulf of Genoa in the Ligurian Sea, Genoa has historically been one of the most important ports on the Mediterranean: Genoa was one of the so-called Repubbliche Marinare along with Venice, Pisa, and Amalfi. Because of the great importance of those four cities, their flags are still part of the Italian National Flag used by the Navy and merchant vessels.

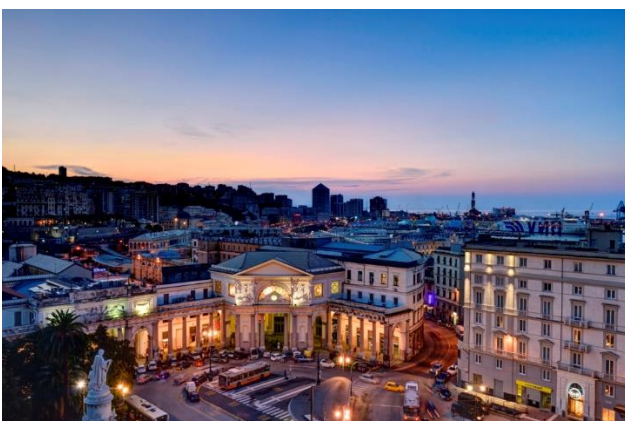
Genoa's nickname is la Superba ("the proud one") due to its glorious past and impressive landmarks. Part of the old town of Genoa is part of the World Heritage List (UNESCO) since 2006 as "Genoa: Le Strade Nuove and the system of the Palazzi dei Rolli".

Genoa is currently one of the busiest ports in Italy and in the Mediterranean Sea. Some leading Italian companies are based in the city, including Fincantieri, Selex ES, Ansaldo Energia, Ansaldo STS, Edoardo Raffinerie Garrone, Piaggio Aerospace, Mediterranean Shipping Company and Costa Cruises.

Genoa is the birthplace of famous Italian people, such as Cristoforo Colombo, Niccolò Paganini, Giuseppe Mazzini, Renzo Piano.



Meetings will be held at the Grand Hotel Savoia Genoa, located at Via Arsenale di Terra 5, Genoa. Close to the heart of the city, this hotel puts you in easy reach most iconic tourist destinations. The Hotel is close to the main train station of Genoa, Genoa Piazza Principe.



2. ACCOMMODATION & RATES

For all meetings, there are standard rooms available in two hotels one next to each other.

The first hotel is the **Grand Hotel Savoia Genoa******, where the meeting will be held.

Special rates are (including breakfast and wi-fi):

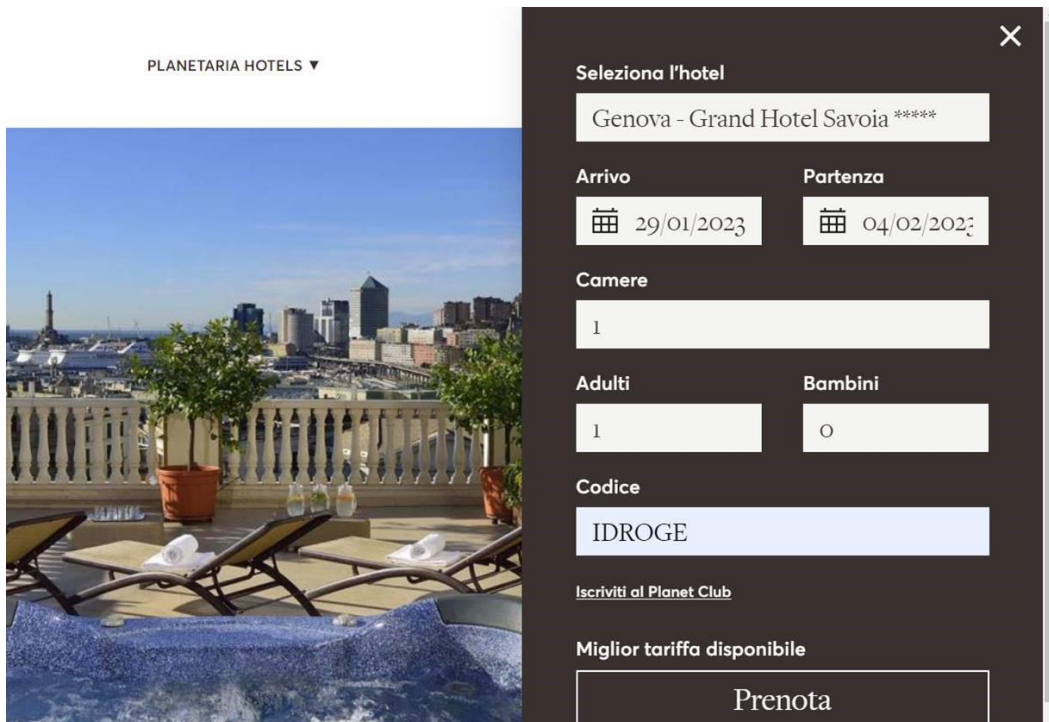
- 102 € per night, classic room;

Both hotels have a private car park. The price is 25€ per day, per vehicle.



3. TRANSPORTATION

Following services are available:

- Taxi: from Genoa Airport to the city centre, the taxi fare is approximately 50€. Journey time - approx. 20 minutes.
- Bus: a direct shuttle service (web site <https://www.amt.Genoa.it/amt/trasporto-multimodale/volabus/english-version/>) from Genoa airport arrivals to Piazza Principe railway station is available.
- Train: trains to Genoa Piazza Principe station from Milano (travel time 2 hours) and from Roma (travel time 4 hours) are available during the day.
- Car: follow “Genoa Piazza Principe Train Station” directions. Both the hotels are located in front of Piazza Principe train station.

5. VISA

6. PLUGS AND VOLTAGE

In Italy, the power sockets are of type F and L. The standard voltage is 230 V and the standard frequency is 50 Hz.
