


MARINE SPATIAL DATA INFRASTRUCTURE

- Collaboration at the UN level UN-GGIM
- Need to address the land/sea interface
- Ability and willingness to share data is imperative

CAPACITY BUILDING

- Need to continue the work being done with capacity building
 - Funding is challenge
 - CBSC request (Council 2019) for a guaranteed minimum level of funding
 - Capacity Building is greatly dependent on contributions from Member States on a voluntary basis





- ► Further investigate on-line courses, e-learning, and other virtual classroom options
- Save on travel and facilities in the future
- ► How can we close the gap among Member States with regard to the understanding and competency with the use of digital data

CROWD SOURCE BATHYMETRY



- Member State support
 - Focus on areas that receive less survey attention
 - Could be used for navigation and other purposes mentioned in MSDI slides
 - Support for Seabed 2030 and increase IHO DCDB holdings

WEND-100

- Intends to address the expanded catalog of IHO S-100 based products from the WEND Principles perspective
- Initial focus on products that are "integral to safe navigation" and under the purview of the IHO
- Agreed on a tiered approach (still discussing) where different S-100 based products may conform to different levels of principles some products need stronger principles
- Third draft of the principles completed Marc van der Donck chaired drafting team
- Full WG meeting planned for the end of August – focus on principles
