
Surveys

 - Approach to Reykhólar surveyed in 2020
 - Northern part of Breiðafjörður re-surveyed 2017-2019
 - Ferry route: Stykkishólmur Flatey Brjánslækur













Breiðafjörður





New charts & updates


- New Harbour plans and New Editions planned

 - Almost all active ports covered



810 Höfn í Hornafirði 1:10.000 2021 edition (prior ed. 2007)







The only port in Iceland where the approach is a river mouth

 - New edition planned Q4 2021








MSI - Maritime Safety Info.

 - Maritime Safety Information service part there off
 - The ICG VTS services Iceland and Greenland
 - NAVTEX messages in 2020
 - total 11.748 for Iceland and 5.063 for Greenland
 - » The figures include storm and ice warnings


- IS more observer than player

 - how to honor MSDI commitments


- MSP and SDI/MSDI awareness gradually growing

 - Marine & Freshwater Research Institute (MFRI) outside TW







Innovation

- Print on Demand (PoD)
 - Printing of IS charts terminated as off June 1st, 2021
 - PoD launched at the same time.
 - Full PoD service is scheduled for January 1st, 2022.
 - Overseas chart agents with established PoD services offering IS charts
