






At ARHC11 2021:

- Presentation of SWPHC Gap Analysis as an example
- ARHC agreed to set up a project team to direct the ARHC process for implementing the IHO SP including the reporting of SPIs.
 CA to chair. USA, DK, and NO have agreed to participate.







At ARHC12 2022:

- Presentation of ARHC Gap Analysis
- Summary Report ARHC12:
 It is the intent of ARHC to carry out a SP gap analysis on an annual basis.
- However, no action was formulated accordingly.
- SP project team has changed?







SP Gap Analysis 2022

 Highlights a number of goals, such as to come towards a common definition of 'navigationally significant', and towards a common definition of 'adequacy' for SPI 2.2.1.

 But also goals, such as the creation of a web presence, and a further engagement with PAME following the joint MoU







How to proceed from here? / Relevance of continued Gap Analysis?

- A3 decision: A3 approved that Goal 1 of the IHO Strategic Plan and its targets shall have the highest priority in the implementation of the 2024–2026 Work Programme
- Set up a new/revised project team to address the open actions of the SP Gap Analysis of 2022 with focus on actions/task raised in ARHC Gap Analysis (Goal 1)?
