Monitoring of unstable slopes in Uummannaq Fjord System

Since the tragic event of the 2017 rock avalanche in Karrat Fjord, the Greenland Government has initiated monitoring activities in the region, where several big unstable slopes still challenge safe living conditions for the local

population. In 2022 the first natural hazard monitoring system ever in Greenland was installed, and during summer 2023 another monitoring system installation is planned. Ongoing observations and surveys allow to define the geological model, which is used to carry out landslide scenarios and tsunami models with potential run up heights in the villages. For carry out reliable risk assessments, detailed and accurate bathymetric information is key.
