BSHC25 VTC

- 1. As you will recall, the BSHC25 Conference scheduled to take place in Stockholm, Sweden in September 2020, due to the increasing threat of COVID-19 was change by BSHC Members decision to a Video Conference. It is now increasing unlikely that face to face meetings will take place during the remainder of this calendar year. Therefore, in order to preserve continuity and exchange key information, a one day BSHC25 Video Conference, will take place on <u>Tuesday 22nd September 2020, commencing at 09.00 CEST (UTC+2)</u> and concluding no later than 12.15 CEST.
- 2. The meeting will be Chaired by the BSHC Chair, Captain (PLN) Dariusz Kolator, and managed by the Hydrographic Office of the Polish Navy, using MS Teams as the communication platform.
- 3. This information letter gives the authority and is designed to aid BSHC Members to make their arrangements to take part in the one-day BSHC Video Conference.
- 4. Confirmation of attendance and registration should be completed as soon as possible but no later than Tuesday 08th September 2020.
