- Cabo Verde became the 99<sup>th</sup> IHO Member State (4.033 km<sup>2</sup>) in 2023



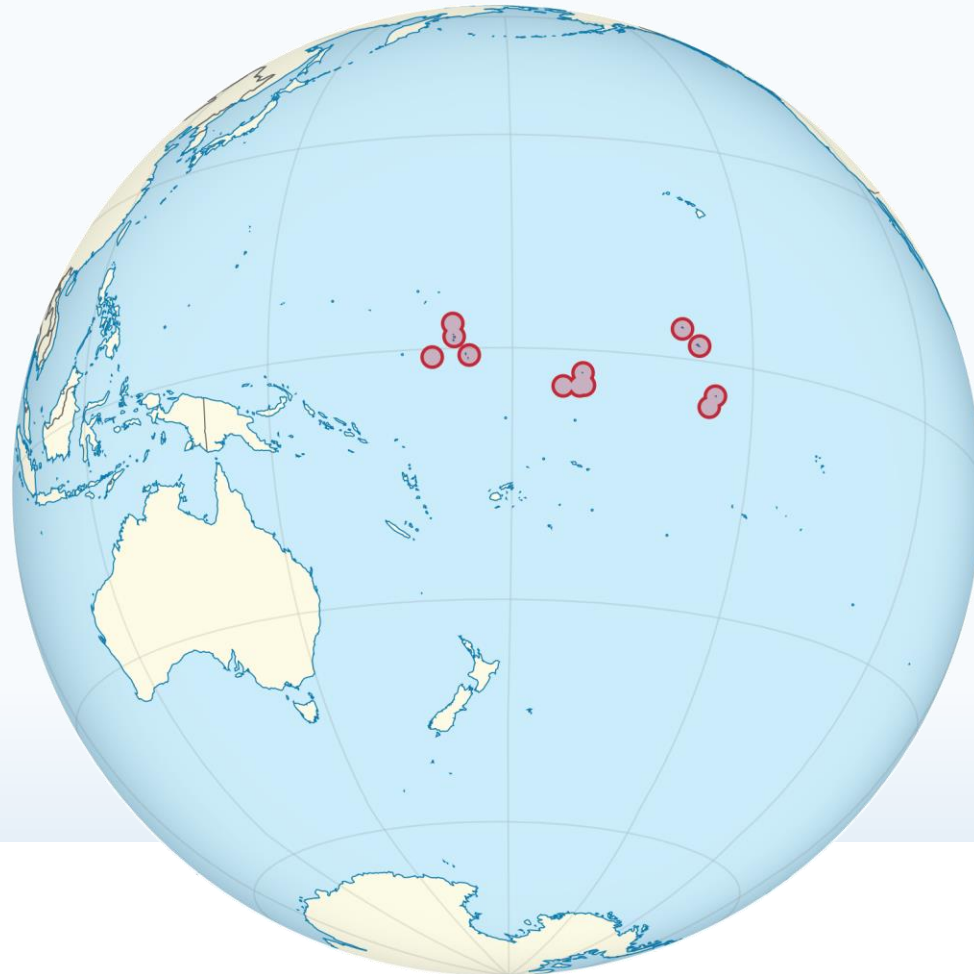

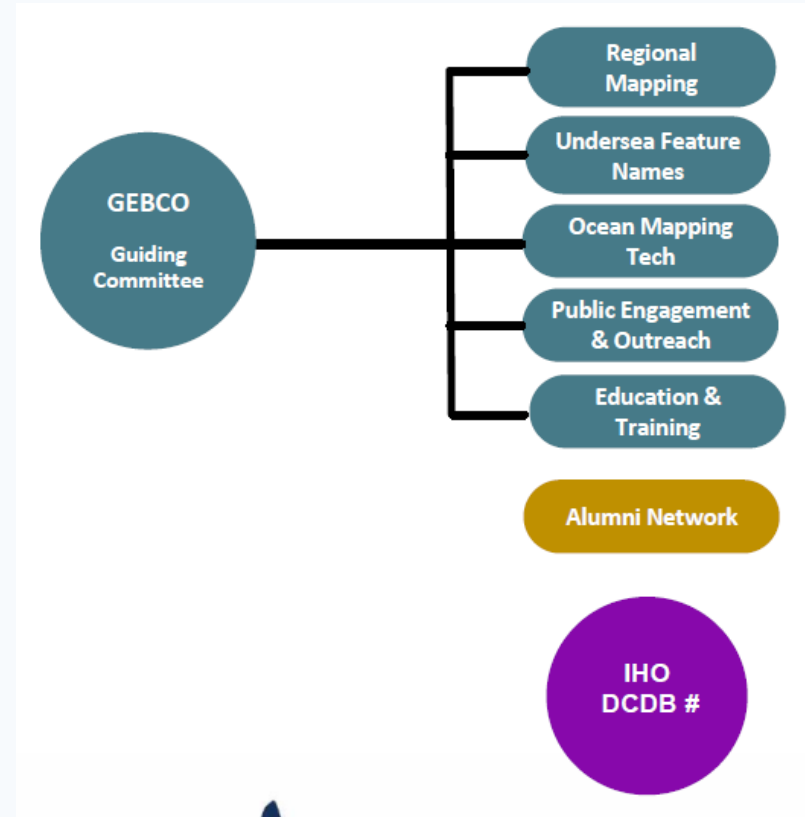

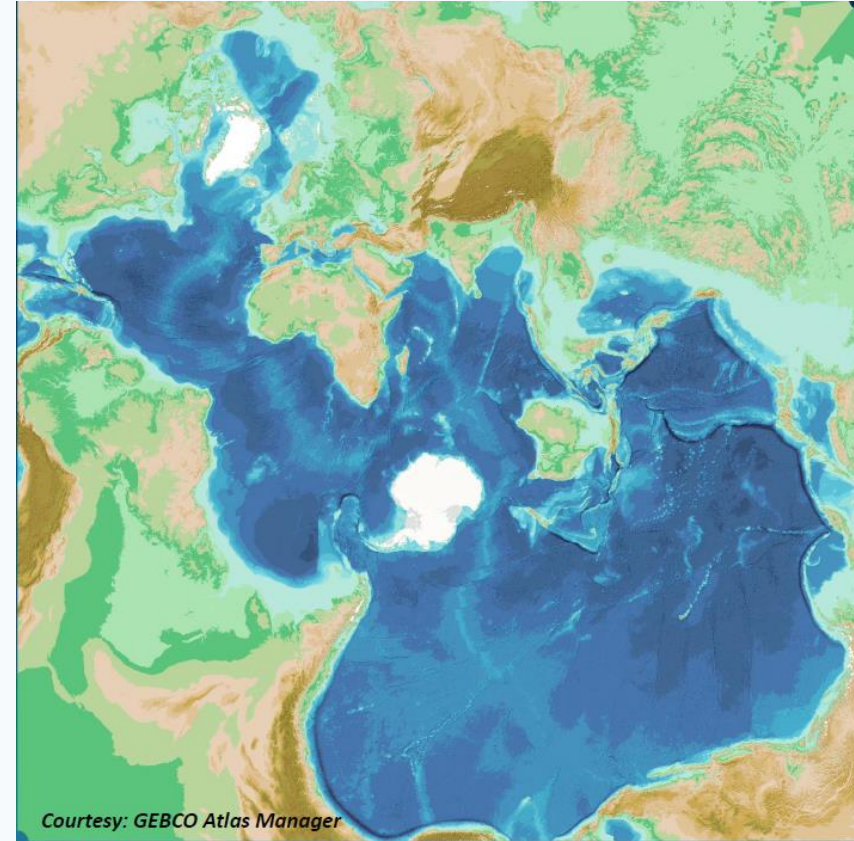
