What is SPRWG

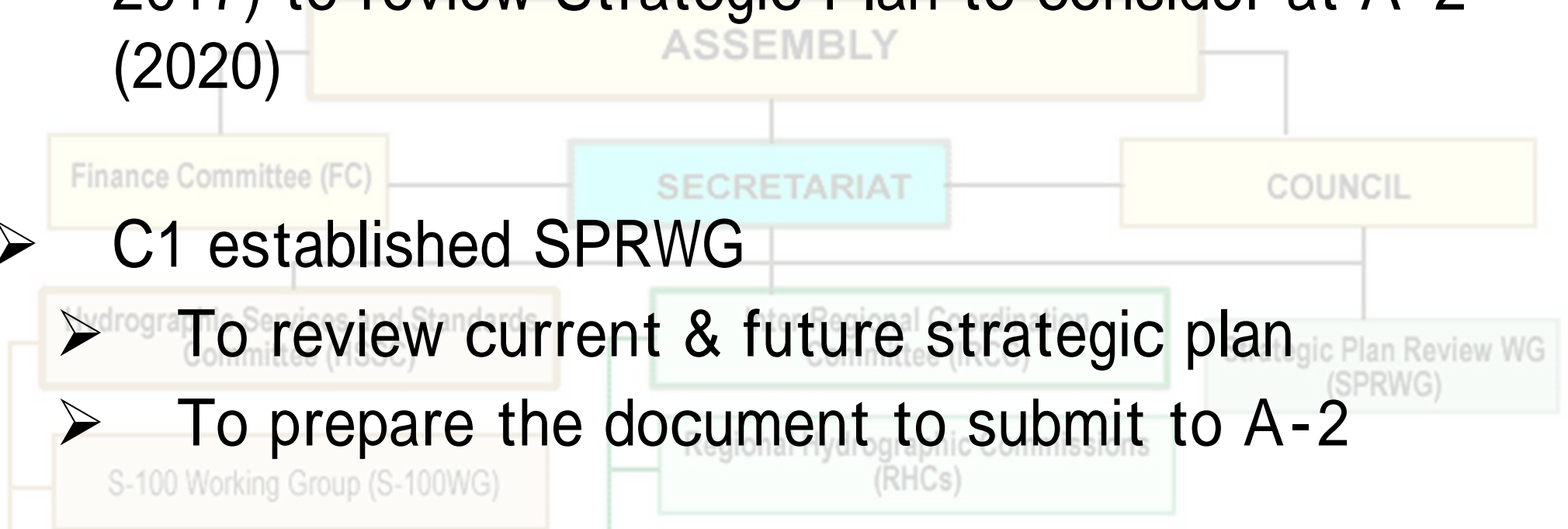
International Hydrographic Organization

- Assembly-1 (Apr, 2017) directed Council-1 (Oct, 2017) to review Strategic Plan to consider at A-2 (2020)

- C1 established SPRWG

- To review current & future strategic plan

- To prepare the document to submit to A-2



Who is SPRWG composited of

- Open to all MSs
- Chairs of HSSC, IRSS, FC should participate
- Chair: Mr Bruno Frachon (FR)
- Vice C: Mr Shigeru NAKABAYASHI (JP)
- Sec.: Mr Douglas BRUNT (CA)
- CN, ID, JP, KR, SG from EAHC



- Normally done by correspondence: e-mail, OneNote
- Face to face at IRCC 10 (Jun, 2018) thx Parry-san
- C-2 (Oct, 2018)
- Drafting team mtg. (Jan, 2019)

- General draft including Visions, Missions, Objectives, Goals, targets are drafted
- Comments are requested to IRCC and HSSC
- C-3 are requested to discuss and finalize the submission paper to A-2

- New SP is admitted by A-2 (2020)

- With intense contribution via correspondence,
- From-scratch discussion at an ad-hoc meeting in IRCC 10, and
- Critical discussion at C-2,
- General structure of the next SP,
- Goals to reach Visions, Missions, Objectives defined by Convention, and
- Ways to Goal (called “targets”) are generally agreed and drafted

- Visions, Missions, Objectives (Convention related)
- Goals
 - Evolving the support of safe and efficient navigation
 - Developing use of marine environment geospatial information for societal benefits
 - Promoting IHO as a key partner on the Ocean scene
- 8 targets are drafted

- To IRCC Chair:
 - Comments on draft targets
 - Take SP into consideration to prepare WP

- To IHO MS: Active contribution (don't be shy!)

- To IHO non MS: take note to prepare to join IHO

- Full of Euro-(N)American contributions
- Lack of Asian's

- Focus on state-of-the-art
- Still not forget global capacity develop
