## News ideas to be studied in 2024 for 2025, 2026 and later (2/2)

- ➤ If countries have not already survey ships, they now often have basic equipment (GPS, SBES, Hypack) allowing them to survey in harbours (small embarkation) and access. What could be missing is **training with their own equipment.** IHO actions should complement the country's own capabilities and not substitute for them. Still need to know them
- ➤ Revisit African maritime academies capable of developing courses in marine sciences and techniques integrating hydrography and physical oceanography (Morocco, Ivory-Coast/ARSTM, Ghana/RMU, Nigeria ...)
