Meeting Venue

The MACHC23 Meeting will be taking place at the TREX / Moonshot Labs facility located at 911 Washington Avenue, Saint Louis, Missouri, USA.






The TREX / Moonshot Labs facility is across the street and one block to the west of the Marriott Saint Louis Grand Hotel. The Meeting will be taking place in the large meeting room on the 5th Floor of the TREX / Moonshot Labs facility building. There are additional smaller breakout rooms that will be used throughout the week on both the 4th and 5th Floors. Translation will once again be through the Interactio online translation tool this year. Please come prepared with a headset, or ear buds in order to hear the translation from either your computer or phone at the meeting.

Accommodations

The MACHC23 participants are recommended to stay in the Marriott Saint Louis Grand Hotel located at 800 Washington Avenue, Saint Louis, Missouri, USA.

MACHC23 participants are expected to make their own accommodation arrangements at the Marriott Saint Louis Grand for convenience and relative location to the events that week. This hotel is offering a special rate of \$141.00 USD per night for MACHC23 participants to stay there. The special rate includes 1 breakfast voucher per room per day for those staying at the hotel. Participants must ensure that they make their hotel reservation by Saturday, 05 NOV 2022 at 1800 hours CT (UTC/GMT -5 hours) to receive the special rate. Marriott Saint Louis Grand Amenities Include:

Transportation

The nearest airport for both international and domestic flights is the Saint Louis Lambert International Airport (STL). It is about a 25-minute drive from the airport to the downtown Saint Louis area.

Below are some transportation options from the airport:

- MetroLink Light Rail
 - o Trains run every 7-15 minutes depending on the time of day.
 - Ticket from Airport to Downtown is about \$4.00 USD one way. Day passes can be purchased for \$7.50 USD per day.

Weather

Late Fall in Saint Louis can be a period of transition. The average daytime highs can range between 46° F (8° C) to 56° F (13° C). The average lows can range between 30° F (-1° C) to 37° F (3° C). The days can either be sunny and clear or cloudy with rain during this time of year.

Official Language

The official language is English. Signage at most airports have Spanish translations. The Marriott plans to have Spanish speakers on staff the week of the MACHC Meeting to assist with check-in and any questions. Should the participant require assistance, please contact the host.

Tourist Information

The hotel is in walking distance to the downtown area. There are numerous museums and attractions nearby. Saint Louis is known for its large Steel Arch located along the banks of the Mississippi River. The Arch represents the gateway to the West. Electrical Power

The main voltage found in the USA is 120 V 60 Hz, plug Type A and B. Participants from countries with 220V might need a transformer to protect their electronic devices.
