#### IRCC15 12-14 June Tokyo, Japan

15<sup>th</sup> meeting held in Tokyo, Japan 12-14, June 2023. Hosted by JHOD, the Hydrographic and Oceanographic Department of the Japanese Coast Guard.

IRCC15 had a particular focus on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Session of IHO Assembly's Decisions affecting IRCC prior to C-7 to increase efficiency.

A-3 tasked Council to revise the Strategic Plan for 2027 – 2032

- IRCC will be very much involved in this
- Will include a review of the Strategic Performance Indicators



#### **IRCC** Highlights – A-3 Decisions

Discussion of Pro 3.5 to A-3 "Establishment of a task force to explore the potential merits, structures, and options for alternate fund generation to support capacity building and other IHO initiatives - Establishment of a scoping Team under the leadership of Dr John Nyberg to investigate potential sources of funding.

- PT Composition, the team's timelines and objectives
- Discussion around possible opportunities such as
  - ENC surcharge
  - Voluntary contributions
  - Development Banks





IRCC decided to continue utilising online workshops for collaboration and knowledge sharing. Identified 2 new workshops for the intersessional period

- Workshop on IBSC submissions
- Benefits and extension of contribution to CSB

These will be developed by the respective Working Groups and bodies in liaison with the IHO Secretariat.





- HSSC presented on the progress and also challenges of the S-100 Implementation Roadmap and S-100 product specifications. IRCC recommended RHCs to start producing S-101 and other S-100 products by focusing on a specific part of the region.
- The IHO eLearning Centre Guidelines were approved. CL24/2023 called for the establishment of the Centres Steering Committee.
- Empowering Women in Hydrography Project to evolve into a programme proposal to C-7
- Subordinate bodies of IRCC are asked to review respective RoP and ToR on gender – inclusive language. RHCS encouraged to also complete this.





- The first run of the WEND IGIF products and services matrix has been completed.
- IRCC approved the MSDIWG ToR v2.0 and endorsed C-17 Ed 3.0.0
- IHO-EU Network Working Group on relevant EU projects was shared, demonstrating the interoperability of data with IHO Standards and opportunities which may assist in extending CB funds
- Demonstration by WWNWS on the C-55 GIS project which will allow easier assessment of data and support SPI reporting and reduce the burden on Member States. Aim to incorporate this into INTOGIS III





- IBSC reported that in 2022 13 submissions for accreditation were recognised (after review), 11 submissions were received in 2023, 1 has been recognised, 3 were not recognised and 8 offered intersessional reviews.
- Internship with IBSC under the EWH Project was very successful
- It was noted that there is a need to update Standards of competence S-5 and S-8.
- The new version of the CSBWG ToR was approved





## **Chair reports**

RHC reports focussed on key regional achievements, key findings and lesson learned.

Main concerns raised related to:

- the challenges of the S-100 implementation Roadmap
- the need for collaboration and coordination needed in S-100 implementation
- the need for Capacity Building activities at regional levels to encourage regional participation
- Data collection in remote locations.

Key achievements related to:

- Inter-regional cooperation
- Successful partnerships with Industry and International Stakeholders
