Generalities

- MoU signed in 2012 by the IHO and the European Commission (EC) on common interests
- 10 years after, the IHO and the EC has valued the activities involving HOs and supported by the EU
- Representatives of RHCs having EU Member States, such as the MACHC, the IHO secretariat and other EU HOs as observers are networking on ongoing projects and opportunities - France represents the MACHC
- France re-elected as chair at the IENWG14 29 May 2024





Reminder of the 10th anniversary of the IHO-EU MoU

IHO and EU has highlighted the **ongoing collaboration**:

- Bathymetry to GEBCO within the European Maritime Observation network (EMODnet)
- Value of hydrographic data for all maritime issues because of IHO standards (collection, products, good practice)
- Some lack of knowledge identified and first hydrographic data collected for science and infrastructure

European Commissioner for environment, oceans and fisheries drew up his vision for the coming years:

- "Because hydrographic offices have become data-centric [...], we are able to progress with all the Green Deal objectives"
- "We now need to see if the right data are being collected"
- "We now need to work together to make this happen [...] in line with the United Nation's Decade of Ocean Science [...]. The IHO's S-100 standardised data services form a technical basis for [...] integration of marine knowledge"

IENWG14 - in Denmark, 29 May 2024


- Meeting held in the margin of the European Maritime Day 2024 welcomed by Denmark

- Update on EU maritime policies, information on experience and opportunities with various EU projects involving HOs
- Progress of the IENWG Work Tracks (endorsed by the IRCC in 2023): data collection, development of the S-100 products and capacity building
- The IENWG has identified to raise awareness of the European Commission for more joint actions in 2025


New: reconduction of EMODnet Bathymetry for 2025-2029 - Other countries have joined with 15 HOs and several research institutes

Key points: interoperable with the IHO DCDB and the IHO and IOC GEBCO

Shared waters – Same standards. Baltic Sea Partnership for Future Navigation

First EU projects 2023-2026 related to S-100 production in Baltic Sea

• E-Nav

To test and implement S-100 products (S-101 on the major routes of shipping and some S-102, S-104 and S-111) Guidelines for harmonization across limits of charting responsibilities

• MaDaMe

To develop AtoN information service (S-125), Navigational Warnings (S-124), VTS service (S-212)

To use the Maritime Connectivity Platform (MCP) and VHF data exchange (VDES)


BSHC HOs in partnership with other national bodies and the **RENCs PRIMAR** and IC-ENC
