International Hydrographic Organization

- To prepare a draft to the future CBSC19 and present it to IRCC in June 2021
- Necessity to have SPI's to measure the success of the CB activities better than the actual ones (only measuring the level of execution)
- To adapt the CB Strategy to the new IHO Strategic Plan and align it with the IHO Strategic Goals
- To deal with the prioritization of the S-100 and how MSI is faced
