- A Project Team under the CBSC to draft a revised Capacity Building Strategy, adapted to the new IHO Strategic Plan and aligned with the IHO Strategic Goals, and to deal with the prioritization of the S-100 and how MSI is faced
- The C55 PT is put on hold, as further work is dependent on the development of the S-100 products
- Member States who have experience in developing and providing e-Learning contents should consider actively sharing contents, resources, and experience with the e-Learning PT
