Dear colleagues,

We hope that you all remain well in these times of war, conflicts and the pandemic, when the effort to continue with our work is even more appreciated. We are a few short days away from the 23<sup>rd</sup> Conference of the Mediterranean and Black Seas Hydrographic Commission (MBSHC). I want to express my thanks to all delegations who have registered for in-person attendance, I think that this Hydrographic Commission requires a meeting with the wider attendance possible to progress with some vital issues for its efficient performance. Also, please be reminded of the importance of remote participation by those who are unable to travel to Slovenia, because we will be discussing major issues which require a quorum according to the Statutes of the MBSHC.

Please find attached a draft timetable for the conference as Annex I. This file will be uploaded to the MBSHC section in the IHO website, and will be updated as required.

I want to highlight two core items:

- First, the need for a Region F ICCWG Coordinator. Spain will be acting as coordinator for urgent ICCWG issues up to the next meeting, and it is imperative that a Member State takes over this vital role for any Regional Hydrographic Commission, but specially for the MBSHC.
  - Following the Statutes, when the conference ends the Vice Chair will take over as the MBSHC Chair, and a new Vice Chair will be nominated, normally the host of the next conference. We need to finish the conference with the nomination for a new Vice Chair, so we encourage Member States to come forward and apply for this post.

Finally, considering the current situation of our Region in the Black Sea, I think that it is very important to update our Disaster Response Framework (DRF). Please find attached the text of the DRF circulated by CL 01/14, which should have been adopted by the MBSHC19 conference, but was not. We propose the adoption of this text as the DFR for MBSHC by MBSHC23 and, if so adopted by the plenary, introduce a new action to revise it.

I want to thank Slovenia for their good work and cooperation to arrange the in person meeting. I look forward to meeting you all in Ljubljana, where I am sure we will have a most successful conference.

### THE DRAFT DISASTER ACTION PLAN for MBSHC

In case a disaster happens within the region;

1. The Chair shall be responsible for co-ordinating the actions needed.

2. The Chair will communicate, by the quickest means available, with the <u>relevant</u> focal points (preferably the Heads of the Hydrographic Offices) of the States in Table-1, in order to make an initial evaluation of the extent of the damage <u>and the actions required (e.g. re-survey of the navigationally most sensitive areas, promulgation of MSI etc.-see resolution 1/2005, as amended).</u>

3. The Chair shall ask the State(s) affected for the official request of support and cooperation in context of Table-2.

4. In case of an official request is received, the Chair shall <u>ask the focal points what assistance could be</u> <u>provided iaw Table-2 and</u> decide, based on the information collected, whether an extraordinary meeting of the MBSHC is needed <u>or not</u>, in order to discuss in detail the problems, evaluate the damage and respond to requests for support.

5. The Chair shall inform the IHB on the situation, the actions taken and the need, if any, for external support.

6. The Chair shall monitor the progress of the actions agreed in the area and keep the MBSHC States and the IHB informed accordingly.

7. The Chair shall include this issue as a permanent agenda item in the MBSHC meetings in order to monitor the readiness of the Commission to respond to disasters, conducting regular table-top exercises to evaluate the procedures and revise the plan.

8. In case of the disaster occurs in State the Chair and he/she is unable to perform his/her duties, the Vice Chair of the last meeting will act as the Chair.

Note: <u>If</u> any Bilateral/Multilateral Support and Cooperation Protocol <u>exists on this matter, it</u> <u>should</u> beannexed to the plan.
