





#### **IHO Strategic Plan target 2.3**

Apply UN shared guiding principles for geospatial information management in order to ensure interoperability and extended use of hydrographic data in combination with other marine-related data.

### S-100 principles article 2.4

The 'Guidelines on the implementation of the WEND-100 Principles' are subject to an approval process with proposals by IRCC for consideration by the Council and following decision by the Assembly. This way Members States control the implementation of S-1XX products over time as IMO and other <u>overarching regulations</u> or guidelines evolve. Note: One of these –overarching regulations- being the UN-GGIM principles on an Integrated Geospatial Information Framework (IGIF) and how these apply to safe navigation and other use cases
