- Coordination with SHOM on overlap and handover of chart coverages
- Preparations for Paper Chart production
- Preparations for release of 3 additional ENCs.





Main challenges

- Migration to S-1xx products
- High running cost

Lessons Learned

- The importance of coordination and mutual understanding between hydrographic offices
- the need to start procedures within the IHO for chart release early during the chart production process

- Conduct more trainings on the conversion/migration to S-1xx products
