- IC-ENC: e-learning package Learning Management System (LMS) (for Members)




Contribution from UKHO

Problems Encountered

- CBSC engagement (3 RHCs were unable to attend CBSC22 in person)
- Training Engagement (2-4 seats remained vacant for the training)
- Limited CB fund
- Need of Phase 2-3 Training

IHO Capacity Building Work Plan-2025

Key Points

- The Work Programme allocates <u>60,000 €</u>
- With additional funds stands at **189,061 €** for 2025
- The accepted submissions would need funds more than <u>577,000 €</u>
- Difference: -387,939 €

Submissions from the RHCs have been prioritized at CBSC22 and has decided to allocate the 2025 budget for mostly the following Activities

- Technical Visits
- Hydrographic Awareness Seminars
- Workshops (like Marine Spatial Planning Workshop)


