



# Logistical & Accommondation arrangements for the NHC66 on 21-22 March 2023

NHC66 is to be hosted by the Danish Hydrographic Office of the Danish Geodata Agency at the Kompas Hotel in Aalborg, Denmark 21-22 March 2023.

The Kompas Hotel was originally founded as Aalborg Seamen's Home back in 1905, but today, functions as modern hotel. The hotel is centrally located and close to the main train station and the central bus stop.


#### **Transport from Aalborg Airport**

## To/From Aalborg, Denmark.

There are several international airlines serving Aalborg Airport with multiple daily flights from Amsterdam, Oslo and Copenhagen.

### **To/From Kompas Hotel**

The international airport of Aalborg is situated right at the edge of the city and connected by a 10 min train or bus ride to Aalborg's main train and bus station. From here, the hotel is to be reached within 15-20 min walking.

Alternatively, travelers can catch an official taxi waiting in front of the terminal building. A taxi to the hotel will be around 200 DKK (around 27 €).


