Secretariat's work, Council matters and Work Programme items

- IHO membership stands at 98. Panama indicated the strong intention to accede. Bolivia came in with questions.
- Unfortunately, Serbia and Syria remain suspended from Member States rights. Lebanon about to join the list.
- Recommendation: *NHC is invited to further assist the Secretariat in promotion of membership to those States not yet IHO Member States.*



6th IHO Council (October 2022)

- The C-6 discussed, endorsed and finally forwarded 7 (out of 15) Proposals including the triennial Work Programme and Budget Estimates for 2024 – 2026.
- Council has become the main topical contributor to Assembly.
- Thanks to NHC members for proactive and relevant support on Council issues but even so for participation on various Working Groups & Project Teams!

- Future production and provision of amending S-1xx products. (to be reported to IMO via IHO Sec.)
- Future provision of paper charts.

- S-164 Test data set





Most relevant themes related to Goal 2: Increasing the use of hydrographic data

Observations:

- Uptake of blue economy along all coasts fish farming, sea weed etc.
- Increased request for deep ocean bathymetry for exploitation, renewable energy production, cable, pipelines, deep water warfare etc.
- Private enterprises and digital philanthropists endeavored ocean bathymetry as an area to receive public attention.
- Revitalization of the GEBCO programme with SeaBed2030 project and Map the Gaps as a booster.



- IHR will issue a jubilee edition to celebrate its centenary. Paper version will be distributed at Assembly kindly produced and sponsored by Germany.
