eMSP NBSR project... brings together national and regional authorities responsible for MSP, research organisations and intergovernmental cooperations from North and Baltic Sea Regions.

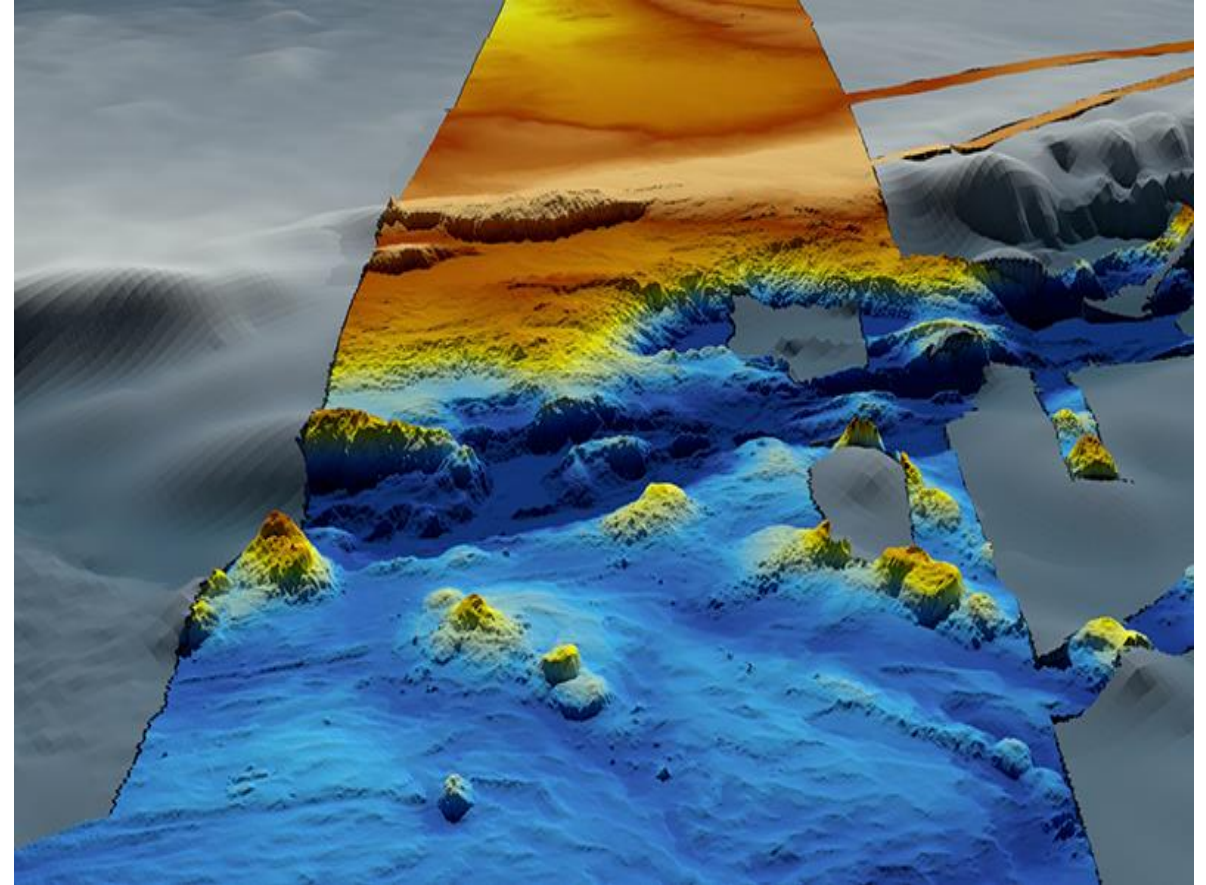
eMSP NBSR project considers European Green Deal... addressing climate change and achieving climate-neutrality targets overarching topics to be addressed in MSP.

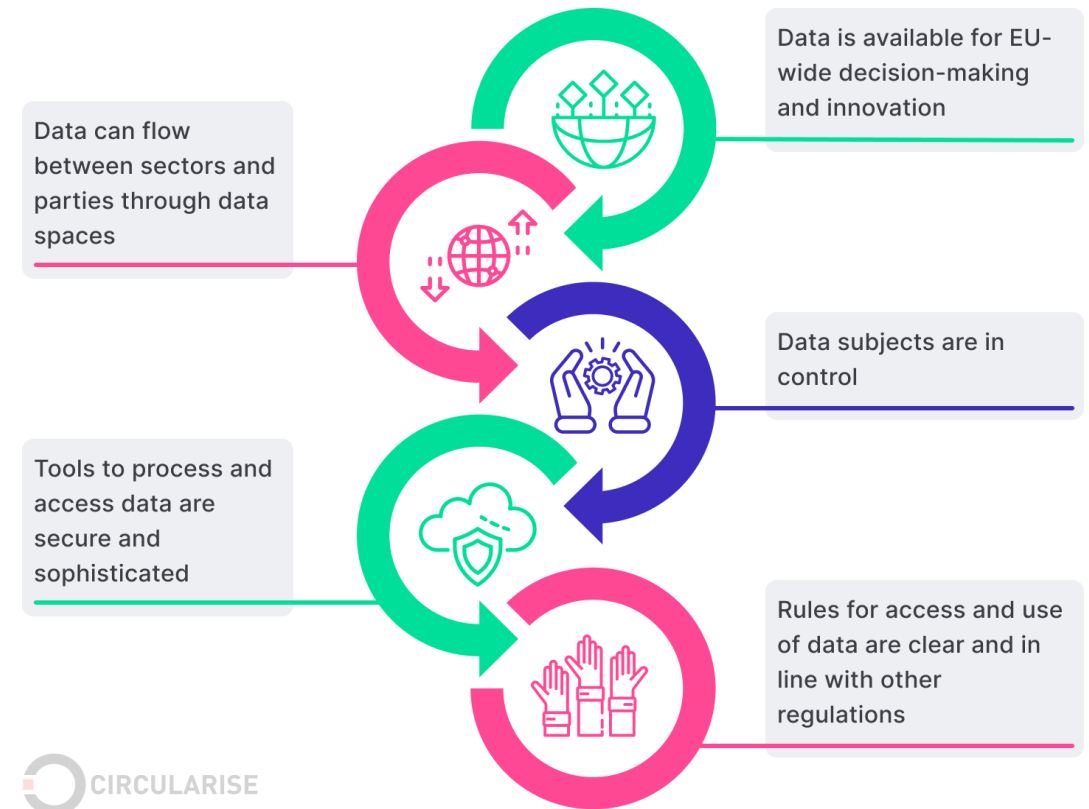
