1. Opening.

- 1.1 The 18th NIOHC meeting was inaugurated by VAdm Girish Luthra, PVSM, AVSM, VSM, ADC Flag Officer, Commanding in-Chief, Western Naval Command. VAdm Vinay Badhwar, Chief Hydrographer, Chairman NIOHC in his opening address welcomed the chief guest and all the participants attending the 18th NIOHC meeting and highlighted the importance of Hydrography in the economic and infrastructural development of the region. India Thereafter, VAdm Girish Luthra, PVSM, AVSM, VSM, ADC Flag Officer, Commanding in-Chief, Western Naval Command delivered the Key note address and wished the participants fruitful deliberation and a comfortable stay in Goa.
- 1.2 The list of Participants who attended the 18th NIOHC meeting is placed at **Appendix A**.
- 1.3 The Chair of NIOHC-18, VAdm Vinay Badhwar informed the participants about the contribution of Indian National Hydrographic Office through its hydrographic services and training in ENC production in the North Indian Ocean Region. The Director IHO, RAdm Mustafa Iptes (Retd) greeted all the participants and appraised the gathering about IHO activities in the Region.

- 1.4 <u>Administrative Arrangements</u>. The participants were briefed in detail about the administrative arrangements and the social calendar for the meeting.
- 2. **Approval of the Agenda and 17th NIOHC Report**. The Chairman approved the agenda, time table and the 17th NIOHC report.
- 3. <u>17th NIOHC- List of Actions</u>. The meeting reviewed the action list of the 17th NIOHC meeting held in Egypt.
- Membership of IHO and NIOHC. IHO provided an update on initiatives taken to encourage Jordan, Maldives and Sudan to become Associate Members of the NIOHC and full membership of IHO. A high level visit to these countries was recently concluded by IHO. This point was considered to be ongoing and the committee decided to retain this item in the NIOHC 18 action list.
- 3.2 <u>Participation in IHO Meetings</u>. RAdm Mustafa Iptes (Retd) expressed IHO's concern on the low participation in IRCC, HSSC and related IHO working groups. He urged MS to actively participate and contribute.
- 4. Participation and Membership of NIOHC. The Chairman welcomed Indonesia as a member of NIOHC. He further requested Indonesia to sign the NIOHC statutes and forward it to IHO Secretariat by end May 2018. He also recommended inclusion of this point as item No. 3, Agenda 4.1 in the Action list of NIOHC18.

8. NIOHC Committees and Working Group reports.

8.1 <u>NICCWG</u>. India provided an update on the out come of the NICCWG meeting held on 09 Apr 18. A report of the NICCWG meeting with action points is attached at **Appendix C**.

9. Capacity Building.

- 9.1 The regional CB Coordinator, UK provided a brief on the activities undertaken in the region during 2017-2018 and proposals for 2018-2019. The CB Coordinator also highlighted the initiatives from India and UK towards conducting programmes other than those funded under the CB programme. The 16th meeting of Capacity Building Sub Committee (CBSC) is scheduled from 30 May to 01 June 2018 in Goa, India. India has agreed to conduct a workshop on MSIS in 2019 under CB programme.
- 10. MSI and NAVAREA Report. India presented the NAVAREA VIII report being the coordinator. The MSI broadcasting system was highlighted and the country-wise status of MSI request received in the

region was shared. The issue of late receipt of MSI for promulgation was emphasized and the MS were urged to provide the MSI information promptly for timely promulgation. The MSwere requested to forward information directly to India at msis-inho@navy.gov.in and navarea8@gmail.com for early dissemination.

The purpose of this document is to provide guidance to mariners to help them collect and contribute crowd sourced bathymetric data in a format that is useful to the broadest possible audience.
- 12. <u>Satellite Derived Bathymetry (SDB)</u>. India presented a case study on "Bathymetry Data Extraction using multispectral data processing technique". This technique can be used as a reconnaissance tool for hydrographic surveying and charting. UK also shared their experience on satellite derived bathymetry.

- 1. **Opening**. Vice Admiral Vinay Badhwar, Chairman NICCWG welcomed all the Members and delivered the opening address.

- 3. The above agenda items, their current status and course of actions were discussed sequentially. The outcome of these deliberations are as follows:-
- 4. Agenda 5.1. The Chair requested Members to provide information pertaining to revision/publication of their respective INT charts from time to time to keep the IHOs Digital INT chart catalogue(INT GIS) duly updated.

5. **Agenda 7.1**

(a) The Chair requested member states to submit the first edition of their INT charts in .pdf format to the NICCWG Coordinator and the Members to expedite the review process. The Vice Chair

explained the need of circulating the. *Pdf* to all the members of NICCWG as NICCWG is a group rather than individual. The consultation process would make the INT scheme more meaningful by resolving the-interregional coverage issues prior to publication. IHO gave a brief about the purpose of Digital INT chart catalogue and the need to keep the currency of the information in view of safety of navigation at sea.

- (b) The Chair, proposed the cut off date as 30June2018 for updating the information on INT GIS by the Member States alongwith the C55 and P5 information.
- (c) Egypt informed that they would be replacing 02 existing INT charts in Gulf of Suez area within next year.
- (d) Sri Lanka and Saudi Arabia are requested to forward the new INT chart proposal as the same is pending.
- (e) The INT chart coordinator area 'J' informed the NICCWG members that no correspondence has been received from Coordinator Area 'I'.
- (f) Bangladesh has incorporated the correction on their first edition of INT charts .The change to the upper latitude of INT7453 onto INT GIS would also be incorporated. INT Charts are now approved subject to final technical adjustments. Regional coordinator of NIOHC will make necessaryupdateinPartBofS-11.
- (g) After discussion, all the 9 INT charts of Bangladesh have been approved for production post incorporating the observations mentioned during discussion.
- 6. UKHO presented the status of INT charts produced by them since the last NIOHC for the information of all members present.

Towards this, Egypt proposed an amendment to S11 Part B of Area 'J' where GB has been shown as printer nation for the three INT charts produced by them. The Chairman informed that the purpose of having a printer nation is to provide a wider distribution source of INT charts. However, he recommended initiating the process for deletion of GB as printer nation from the INT chart catalogue, S11 part B of Area' J'.
- 9. <u>Conclusion</u>. There being no further points for discussion, the Chairman thanked all the members for their involvement during the NICCWG proceedings and concluded the meeting.
