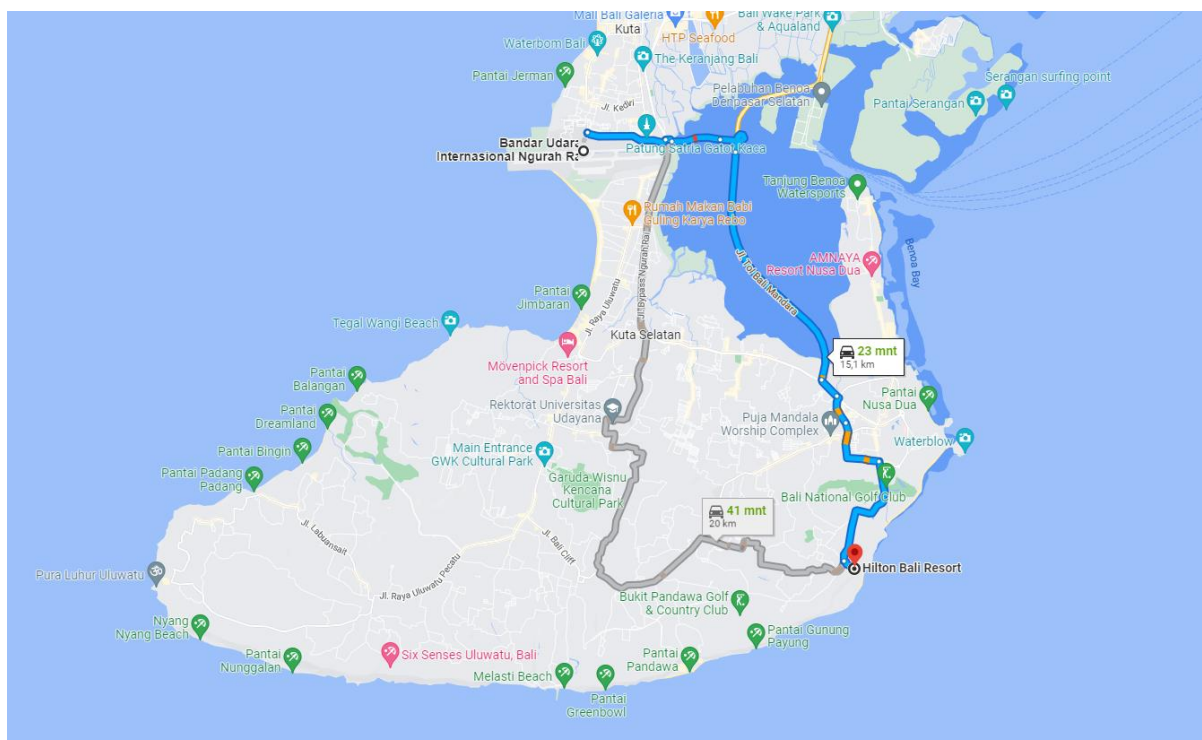


ACCOMMODATION

OTHER INFORMATION

a. Electricity:

The standard voltage in Indonesia is 220 V / 50 Hz. Indonesia holds a standard socket of 2-round pins plug without a ground pin (Type A). Participants are recommended to bring their adaptors to comply with electric current and plugs.



b. Currency:

The local currency is Indonesian Rupiah (IDR).

USD 1 = ± IDR 14,600 (as per May 2022).

c. Weather:

In month of August, the average temperature of 27°C. The climate is burning here this month. August in Bali produces the highest average of daily sunshine, coming in at 10 hours. Along with the most sun throughout the year, August also sees the least amount of rainfall. On average it rains just 40mm over the course of only three days. This month is the peak of the "dry season" in Bali, so lots of sun and hardly any rain makes sense.
