VENUE

Yogyakarta is the capital city of Special Region of Yogyakarta in Indonesia, in the south-central part of the island of Jav. As the only Indonesian royal city still ruled by a monarchy, Yogyakarta is regarded as an important centre for classical Javanese fine arts and culture such as ballet, *batik* textiles, drama, literature, music, poetry, silversmithing, visual arts, and *wayang* puppetry.

The meeting will be held at the Royal Ambarrukmo Hotel. The Royal Ambarrukmo is a 5-star hotel in Yogyakarta was built as directed by Indonesian President Sukarno in 1964. The hotel was built on the site of the former Ambarrukmo Palace, a 19th century royal residence of the Yogyakarta Sultanate, from which the hotel derives its name. The buildings of the former palace still stands and is now housed within the hotel compound.

a. Electricity:

The local currency is Indonesian Rupiah (IDR) USD 1 = ± IDR 15,632 (as per November 2022).

c. Weather:

In month of February, the average temperature of 27°C. February in Yogyakarta produces the highest average of daily sunshine, coming in at 12.3 hours. With an average high of 83°F (28°C) and a low of 75°F (24°C), it generally feels pleasantly warm, humid but cool.
